Whole Class Quarantine

In the case of a whole class closure, here is the framework that Parkside will use. There will be a required combination of Teams/Zoom meetings with the teacher. This format will provide the students with the lessons necessary to continue grade-level progression.

Monday -Thursday Schedule		
Kindergarten -Morning Classes	Class Starts at: 9:00 am.	Classes via Teams/Zoom and Canvas—60 minutes of instruction under the direction of the teacher
Independent Learning		Under the direction of the teacher-ie, ST Math, i-Ready Reading
Kindergarten- Afternoon Class	Class Starts at: 12:30	Classes via Teams/Zoom and Canvas—60 minutes of instruction under the direction of the teacher

Monday-Thursday Schedule	
Grades First-Fourth	
2 hours of instruction time	Classes via Teams/Zoom and Canvas—120 minutes of instruction under the direction of the teacher
Independent Learning:	ie, i-Ready Reading, ST Math, Imagine Math—under the direction of the teacher

Grades Fifth and Sixth	
3 hours of instruction time	Classes via Team/Zoom and Canvas under the direction of the teachers. 5 th and 6 th grade students rotate between teachers. Class times for these rotations will be given to parents and students by the teachers.
Independent Learning:	ie, i-Ready Reading, ST Math, Imagine Math--under the direction of the teacher.

- Teachers will communicate the format and times to you on a class by class basis. Teachers will also post times they can respond to you or your students if you need assistance. Students have been using Canvas as well as the assigned programs. We are confident that they will have the skills to navigate this system.
- If you need your students i-Pad or if there are learning components that involve paper/pencil tasks, the school office will help assist with delivery or pickup of material for quarantined students.
- Fridays will be a remote learning day as usual. The teacher will use this Friday to check in with students who have not been able to participate or small groups of targeted students.
- Classroom teachers will work with Mrs. Egbert to make sure that students with IEP's are getting their service times.
