## COVID-19

### Winter Sports Guidelines

Wildcat Nation,

Winter sports are here, and we are excited to see our Wildcats and Lady Cats back in action!

As we prepare for the upcoming season, we are also taking precautions to help ensure we are following all guidelines set forth by the CDC, DPH, GHSA, and Region 8AA. Our number one priority will always be the safety of our student athletes, coaches, and the Rabun County community as a whole. We appreciate your continued support during these incredible times, and we ask that you please review the following guidelines that we have in place. It will take all of us doing our part to ensure these young men and women have the opportunity to experience a full winter sports season.

#### ➤ Gym Capacity

- The Rabun County High School Gym will operate at 50% capacity.
  - Once capacity is reached, no additional spectators will be allowed to enter the gym.

#### ➤ Ticketing

- Tickets will be limited to 50% capacity, and once capacity is reached, no additional fans will be allowed entry.
  - 150 General Admission tickets will be available at the Gym Main Entrance on gameday.
    - Booster Club All Season Passes will be accepted.
    - Up to 6 Basketball Season Passes per basketball player and cheerleader will be available for sale through the RCHS Front Office.
    - Once tickets are sold out, only passes will be allowed admission.
  - Visiting team Athletic Directors will be provided a private GoFan link with access to 100 tickets for sale to visiting parents and fans.
    - For Region 8-AA games, the visiting team will receive 150 tickets.
  - **All RCSS students must purchase a ticket. All student tickets will include a coupon for a complimentary Coke and popcorn from the concession stand.**
  - Limited complimentary RCHS student tickets will be available in the Front Office on a first come first serve basis the day of a home game/match.
  - There will be no passes out.

#### ➤ Gym Seating

- Spectators are expected to maintain social distancing to the greatest extent possible while in the stands. Household members are the exception.
- Individual rows of seats will be closed off to allow for social distancing, and all fans are expected to adhere to row closures.
- Pre-k through 8th grade students will only be admitted if accompanied by an adult.
- Children must remain in the stands with their parents at all times.

➤ **Spectators**

- All spectators are expected to self-screen for symptoms of COVID-19 prior to traveling to the game. Spectators with fevers or any symptoms of COVID-19 are asked to remain home.
  - Face masks/coverings are required for entry into the RCHS Gym, and they are encouraged to keep face coverings on throughout the event.
  - Pre-k through 8th grade students will only be admitted if accompanied by an adult.
  - Social distancing and COVID-19 prevention signage will be posted throughout the stadium. It is the responsibility of all fans to practice social distancing to the greatest extent possible at all times.
  - All spectators are asked to remain in the stands unless visiting the concession stand or restrooms.
  - No spectators will be allowed on the court before, during, or after the game.
  - All students/children must remain in the stands and under the supervision of their parents at all times. Spectators who do not monitor their children will be asked to leave the gym.
  - No pets allowed on school property at any time. Service animals must be properly identified.

➤ **RCHS Students**

- Students will not be permitted on the court at any time throughout the event.
  - Limited complimentary RCHS student tickets will be available in the Front Office on a first come first serve basis the day of a home game/match.

➤ **Concessions**

- Cashless payment options will be available at all concession stand locations.
- All concession stand workers will be screened for symptoms of COVID-19 prior to working the event. Workers who show symptoms will not be allowed to work the event and will be encouraged to seek medical attention immediately.
- All concession stand workers will be educated in the importance and expectation of increased frequent handwashing.
- All concession stand workers will be required to wear a face covering and gloves when in the presence of other works and spectators.
- Concession stand lines will be clearly marked, and social distancing should be practiced by everyone in line.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be available at all concession stand locations.
- All concession stands will undergo enhanced cleaning and sanitation.
