Go on a number hunt in your house, where else would you spot the number 11? E.g. door number, on a bus, etc. Create a poster representing all the different ways of showing number 11. For example, you might draw 11 snowflakes, 11 penguins, some number sentences to show 11, e.g. 10+1=11, drawing 10 and 1 numicon shape. Learning challenge – to recognise number 11 and represent number 11 in different ways.
