Registration is now open for the "Housing Now! 2018 King County DDD Housing Conference" on March 10 at Highline College. Register online.

This one-day conference, planned in collaboration with King County Developmental Disabilities Board members, Community Homes, and The Arc of King County is designed for people with intellectual and developmental disabilities and their families who seek creative options in planning to meet the housing needs of the adult individual with a disability.

This conference highlights keynote speakers Claudia Balducci, King County Council member, and Ed Holen, executive director of the Washington State Developmental Disabilities Council, as well as 20 workshops across five "tracks," so that everyone can find information they need.

Featured Article: "Akron Zoo becomes just second in country to be designated sensory inclusive"

The Akron Zoo, located in Ohio, has officially become the second zoo in the country to become a certified sensory inclusive zoo. In addition to the zoo providing sensory bags for guests to borrow for free, which includes items such as fidget toys and noise-canceling headphones, the zoo's 120 year-round employees and 150 seasonal workers have been trained to assist sensory sensitive guests.
