Ever wonder what the Jo students are learning? We asked Ms. Bitton, English Department Chair to share what her Senior Literature class is engaged with.

"Currently our seniors are reading and discussing Sula by Toni Morrison; exploring themes like what Morrison calls 'the consequences of [a woman's escape from male rule] on female friendship.' We have been discussing the implications of racist ideology and the ways that justice has been historically withheld from communities of color, specifically black communities. We are also discussing the suffering of soldiers returning home with PTSD and the ways that the United States has fallen short in caring for these individuals."
