Job Summary:

The Snack Bar Supervisor is responsible for maintaining outstanding customer service; short order cooking, processing sales quickly, accurately and efficiently, standardized cash handling procedures, ordering and maintaining supplies, cleaning equipment, and surfaces in the snack bar and supervising snack bar operators.

Essential Job Duties and Responsibilities

- Supervise and schedule part-time Snack Bar Operators.
- Promote a positive, congenial atmosphere in the Student Center with students, faculty, staff and customers.
- Prepare all standard menu items.
- Must remain aware of, and observe Dining Services standards and procedures.
- Must adhere to standardized recipes and advise Chef(s) of any discrepancies.
- Must work varied shifts, including evenings and weekends. Required to report to work promptly at the time stated on the staffing schedule, and take only scheduled breaks.
- Cooperate with management team to ensure an orderly and efficient operation.
- Maintain food and refrigeration temperature logs, and take corrective action when required.
- Assumes the responsibility and shift of the snack Bar Operator in their absence.
- Responsible for proper handling and storage of all foods prepared.
- Responsible for understanding and following HACCP-based SOPs.
- Responsible for the sanitary condition of Snack Bar and dining areas.
- Deliver, set-up, and pick-up of special parties as required.
- Assist in the proper set-up and service of small functions.
- Follow all policies including MSDS, safety and sanitation, as instructed by management and keep informed of all material safety data.
- Required to wear issued uniform including non-slip shoes, hat, shirt and pants and vinyl gloves while handling food.
- Perform other duties as assigned within reason.

Qualifications and Skills Required for Position:

- High school diploma required.
- Prior experience working in management and as a cook in the short order style.
- Ability to oversee and manage daily tasks and to provide deliverables to multiple parties on a daily basis.
- A strong commitment to service is essential.
- Relates to students, faculty, staff and visitors in a cooperative manner that helps others to be their best.
- Ability to process information/merchandise through POS system.
- A mastery of the current principles, practices, operation of equipment, materials, and methods used in large-scale production is desirable.
- Must be extremely well-organized with great attention to detail.
- A high level of integrity, accuracy and work ethic.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills.
- Successful candidate must be able to read and write and perform mathematical computations.
- Successful candidate must have a valid driver's license and be able to drive in Massachusetts.
- Ability to work collegially; must be committed to working in a diverse community and have the ability to communicate effectively with diverse populations; must enjoy working with young people in a boarding school environment.
- Has a demonstrated commitment or experience in justice, equity, diversity and inclusion work.
