PENNCREST Students & Families:

<u>Beginning on December 7, 2020, all PENNCREST Schools will move to an ABABC hybrid schedule.</u> This schedule will continue through the holiday season. On January 11, 2021, we will resume Monday through Friday inperson learning for all of our students. The decision to return on January 11, 2021 is contingent upon the current COVID-19 data trends.

<u>On "A" days</u> (Monday & Wednesday) all students with last names <u>A – K in all grades PreK – 12</u> will report to school for in-person learning. Virtual learning will occur on "B" days. Households with multiple last names can choose day "A" or "B".

<u>On "B" days</u> (Tuesday & Thursday) all students with last names L - Z in all grades PreK – 12 will report for inperson learning. Virtual learning will occur on "A" days. Households with multiple last names can choose day "A" or "B".

<u>On "C" days</u> (Friday) all students will learn virtually. Every Friday the district will deep clean and disinfect all PENNCREST schools.

<u>Crawford County Career and Technical Center students</u> may attend the CTC on <u>"A" and "B" days</u> (Monday through Thursday) but only attend his or her high school on the designated A or B day.

During our ABABC hybrid schedule winter athletics will continue as scheduled.

This information is subject to change based on directives, mandates and guidance from various state and federal departments, agencies and offices. If you have questions or concerns, please contact the building principal. Any deviation from our current learning plan requires principal approval.
