Dear School Community Member,

I am writing to inform you that beginning on December 7, 2020, all Edison Public Schools will transition to fully remote learning until the holiday break which begins on December 24, 2020. We are making this move due to the significant increase in positive COVID-19 cases district-wide this week, and believe this transition is prudent at this time. The decision was also made in consultation with the Edison Department of Health. While the district is in our fully-remote instruction model, our Hybrid Schedule will continue to allow for an easier transition back to in-person instruction when that occurs. At present, we plan to return to our in-person hybrid instructional model on January 4, 2021; however, this depends on numerous external factors related to the virus. A final decision on this will be made closer to the proposed date of return.

We are grateful for your patience and understanding during these challenging times, and I still remain optimistic and confident that our school community will emerge from this crisis stronger than when we entered. We remain committed to living up to our motto of "Nothing Less than Excellence" and are here for Edison's children. Be well, and stay safe.
