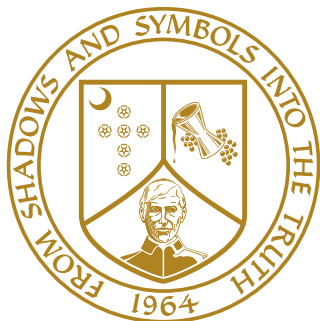

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Dear Cardinal Newman Community,



My heart is bursting with gratitude and appreciation for the kindness and generosity I see expressed daily by the Newman Community. The COVID crisis has caused terrible disruption, yet I see our community persevering with faith, strength and determination, undeterred from its promising future. Despite the hardships - the extended

mandated campus closure, the struggling economy, and health and safety impacts - our students, faculty and staff, families, friends and benefactors have not only stood strong in solidarity with Cardinal Newman High School during this time, but have contributed selflessly towards building Newman's future. I am sincerely humbled by this fact.

This year our Day of Giving was record breaking, achieving 691 gifts to support student learning and raising over \$246,295. I am inspired by the generosity of our faculty and staff in participating in the Day of Giving - 98.6% participated, by our Board of Trustees - 100% participated, by our students - our Junior class had the highest % participation among the four classes, and by our families, alumni and friends - with higher participation rates and more donated contributions to our school this year than last year. What a wonderful expression of support! The funds raised provides tuition assistance and fills the gap between the cost of tuition and the actual expense of educating each student. This level of participation is a testament to our unity and the enthusiastic support our community has for the Mission of Cardinal Newman High School.

Our **A Call to Lead Campaign**, which began in 2018 as a \$38 million dollar campaign, is down to raising its final \$100,000. The new Two-Story Classroom Building, which broke ground on June 22, is on track for students to occupy its classrooms at the start of 2021-2022 school year. Stakeholders are finalizing the design of the new Student Life Center with hopes for its groundbreaking ceremony to occur in Summer 2021. Please help spread the word and encourage to be part of this as we are so close to closing this campaign - and so eager to celebrate its completion!

In this season of gratitude, and in honor of this issue of Trinity celebrating community support:

- **I thank our faculty and staff** for tirelessly carrying out the Mission of Cardinal Newman High School in collaborative, creative, and constructive ways. 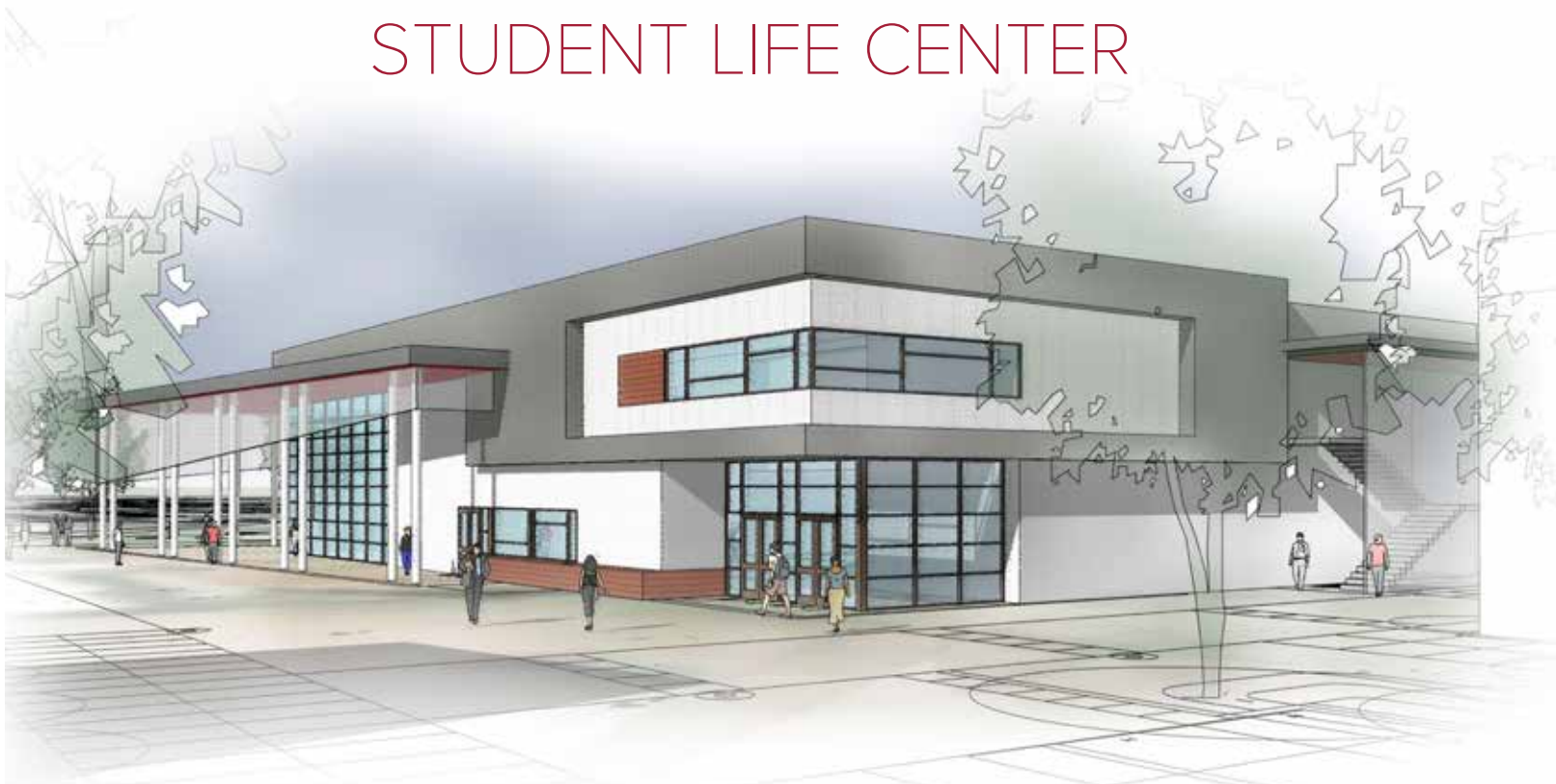
2-STORY CLASSROOM CONSTRUCTION

We'd like to thank our Contractor, Wright Contracting, Quattrocchi Kwok Architects, and the CN Building & Grounds Committee for guiding us through the permit, planning, design and build process! While construction moves forward on the Classroom Building, planning and design continues on the incredible \$16M "Student Life Center". This building will be the "hub" of student activities and gathering on campus. We are close to fully-funding this project with only \$73,143 left to raise! STUDENT LIFE CENTER



CHAPEL

The architect's rendering captures the grandeur and simplicity of the new Chapel on the Cardinal Newman campus. It will be located in the center of campus, and its cupula will be taller than the adjacent gym roof, allowing it to be seen by travelers on Old Redwood Highway.



The new Student Life Center will be the hub of activity for our students. The Center will include a new food service facility with both indoor and outdoor covered seating spaces, offices and work spaces for Campus Ministry, the Community-Based Service Learning program, student activities such as preparations for rallies, dances, Newman News, and will be home for our Chaplain's office. The first floor will be lively and active, and has been noted as the 'campus family room for our students', while the second floor will house the more

academic-focused activities where study groups may gather, at tables or in small work spaces, or on couches and comfortable furniture. Additionally, there will be an innovation center, a studio for recording/broadcasting, a learning lounge, a library, and several small work spaces for group activities. Design work for the facility continues under the guidance of Quattrocchi Kwok Architects, with construction work on the project anticipated to start in the Summer of 2021.



FATHER PLASS' MESSAGE AND PRAYER

It is my honor to provide some words for this issue of Trinity and, most of all, to have begun serving the Cardinal Newman community as Chaplain and Teacher. By way of introduction, I was ordained a Priest on March 7 of this most memorable year, after nearly completing my studies for the priesthood. Christmas presents us with the mystery of Emmanuel, “God-with-us”. We know that God is always with us, but do we ever stop to ask if we are with God? During this season, then, let us make an effort to cultivate a deeper, more loving union with Jesus, the Son of God, Who is always ready to receive us.

HUMAN PERFORMANCE DEPARTMENT

— OVERVIEW —



This year marks the launch of the Cardinal Newman Human Performance Department. The Human Performance Department (formerly the Physical Education Department) is dedicated to the development of the whole student: physical, mental, emotional and spiritual. Programs within the department are interdisciplinary by nature and allow students to explore their sport and physical activity experience from a holistic perspective. Human Performance classes foster a positive learning environment which includes an appreciation of all cultures and respect for all persons. Coursework is designed to promote critical thinking, creativity, leadership and academic honesty.

So far the Human Performance Department has rolled out two new programs this year: the Human Performance Activity Series and the Human Performance Speaker Series. The Human Performance Activity Series provides opportunities for regular physical activity to our entire Cardinal Newman community during our period of remote learning. We offer Zoom Activity Classes several days a week, both before and after school. Our Activity Classes include Body Weight Strength & Conditioning, Flexibility & Core Strength and Pilates. Classes are run as a part of our PE Course Curriculum, but they are open to all Cardinal Newman students.

The Human Performance Speaker Series provides students with an opportunity to learn from guest speakers' experiences with, and reflections on, a variety of topics in the field of Human Performance, including Sport & Social Justice, Sport & Spirituality, Careers in Sport and more. Our Speaker Series Events take place every other Thursday at 7pm via Zoom. Like the Activity Series, the Speaker Series is offered as a part of the Human Performance Department curriculum but it is open to all Cardinal Newman students.

COLLEGE COUNSELING

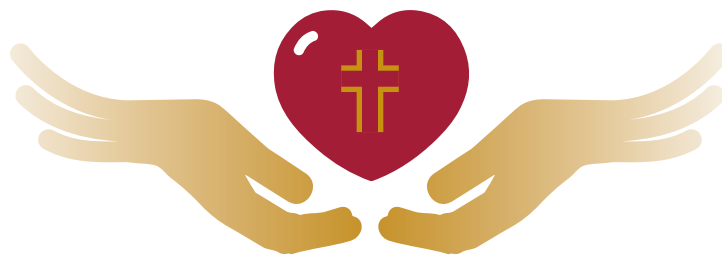
Due to the pandemic, this has been a challenging year for our students and the CN community as a whole. The SAT and ACT college admissions tests have not been scheduled in Sonoma County since March. Many of the colleges across the country have gone test-optional, test-flexible, or test blind for college admissions. Colleges are looking at applications with a holistic approach which can include reviewing the student's coursework, reading the student-submitted essays, teacher and counselor recommendations, honors and awards, and extracurricular activities.

Cardinal Newman College Counselors are meeting with students and their parents via Zoom, answering questions about the college application process, and reviewing college applications for students before they submit them. What we typically do during the

school day, pre-pandemic, we continue to do at a distance and online. We have had more than 50 virtual college visits since September. The College Admissions Representative sets up a Zoom or Webex meeting through our college advising calendar and virtually meets with a group of interested students for a half-hour. Students are able to engage and learn about the college and ask questions to the College Admissions Representative who is typically the person reading the student application.

At the beginning of the school year we were able to visit the Junior and Senior classes to explain how we are working to best serve them during distance learning. We miss seeing our students in our office and are looking forward when they are back on campus so we can see their faces in person and not on the computer screen!

CHRISTIAN SERVICE FROM THE HEART

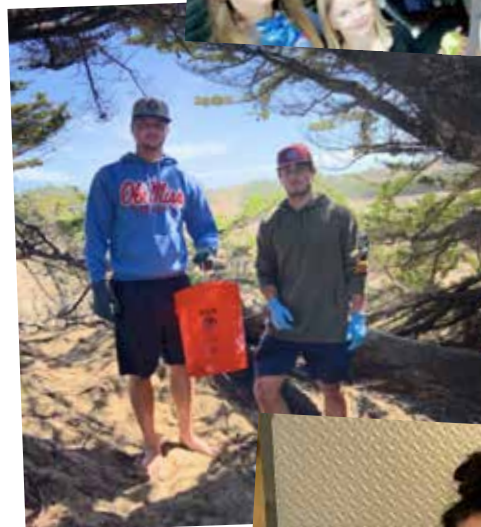

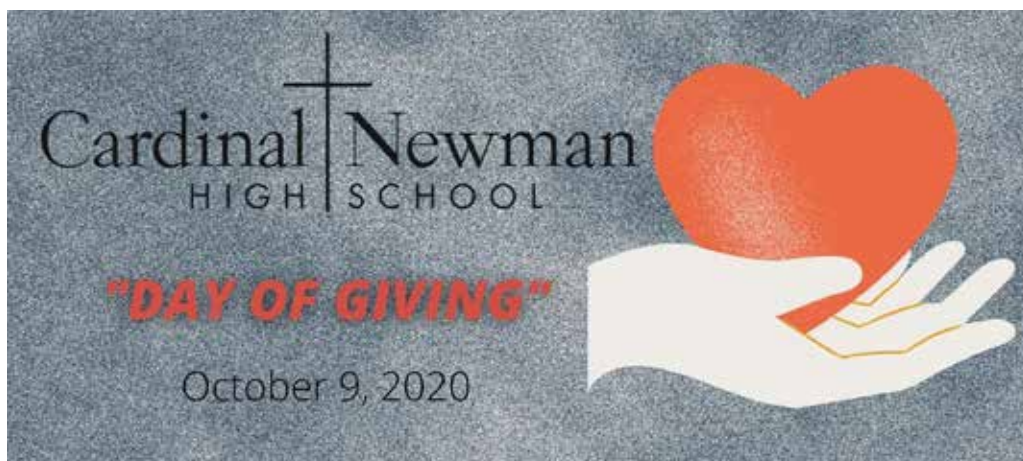

STATE-OF-THE-ART TECHNOLOGY

New technology is being installed in the classrooms that will improve the teaching and learning experience - camera, microphones, large screen monitors - linking students at home with teachers, and when we go into the hybrid model, they will link students at home with the students in the classrooms for a synchronized learning experience. This tech can be used whenever a student is absent from class or when we need to close campus for smoke, flood, or power outage.

The integration of technology has been a monumental task. Students and teachers have been adapting to distance learning since the start of the pandemic in March 2020. The transition from on-site teaching to distance learning commenced rather quickly. CNHS administration made the swift decision to create a new schedule and complete the 2019-2020 school year online. Teachers had to learn quickly how to take their usual in-class lessons and transform them through distance learning. Google Classroom and Aeries have become staples in each classroom, providing students with the information for grades and daily lessons, activities, and assignments. The teaching staff were provided with several training sessions to embrace best practices when it came to the use of technology

in the classroom. This began with the implementation of Zoom conferencing in order to conduct classes where teachers are able to closely monitor how students are performing. Teachers are able to utilize breakout rooms to allow students to work cooperatively and independently, and have begun to model lessons using Avervision document cameras and Zoom whiteboards and have embraced a wider use of websites and Apps including, but not limited to Kahoot, Jamboard, B.Socrative and Edpuzzle.

Due to the COVID pandemic, Cardinal Newman was forced to begin the 2020-2021 school year online as well. We are hoping that this will only continue for the short term. In order to brace for a long-term situation, the school purchased Logitech cameras for each classroom in order to possibly conduct the hybrid model of classroom teaching, one in which some of the students would come onto campus while others received the same instruction through Zoom. Teachers will be able to control these cameras remotely from the front of the room and are able to zoom in closely with the cameras that will be mounted in the back of the classroom. We expect to have installation of the cameras complete by the end of the 2020 fall semester.

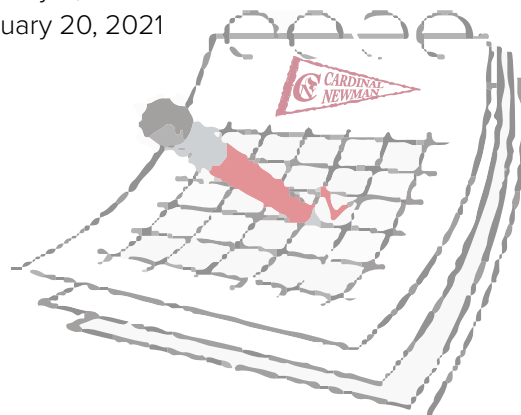
