Dear Homdel Families,

As of today we have 32 students and staff members from all four schools who tested positive for Covid 19 and are in quarantine. Currently, and, going back to November 20th as advised by the Monmouth County Department of Health, we have 18 positive cases at the High School, 5 at Satz, 5 at Indian Hill and 4 at Village. In reviewing these most recent number of individuals who tested positive for Covid 19 since November 20, 2020, consulting with the Monmouth County Department of Health and, following the guidelines from NJ Health and the CDC, specifically page 15 ([NJ Department of Health](#)), we will need to continue full virtual instruction at all four of our schools. The High School, Satz, Indian Hill, and Village will continue virtual instruction for another week; from December 7th through 11th. We will continue to review this decision throughout next week to determine when our students can return to in-person school and when we can move to a full day instructional program; either in person or virtually.

The daily schedule and classroom model is here ([Here](#)). Teachers and support staff will continue to report to school and provide virtual learning from our classroom settings. If you have any questions, please contact your principal. During this time, all extra curricular activities are suspended.

While our students may not be in school at this time, it is imperative that everyone continue to practice CDC guidelines...wear a mask and maintain 6' social distancing. Please notify your child's principal if your child tests positive at this time.
