Remote Learning Expectations



A reminder for all students and families around the expectations and attendance during remote learning.

These are the highlights from our assemblies earlier this fall so you are able to review them with your student:

- On remote days, all students should be answering the question of the day in their TA/Homeroom Google Classroom by 2:00pm or they respond to an email sent by their TA teacher. This only accounts for attendance, this is not academic work.
- All students are expected to do their best on their academic work this means to take your time and to be thorough. Students are <u>not</u> expected to always have everything correct. Students should email their teacher if they get stuck and students should attend Google Meets for academic help as well.
- Students should always try to access the Google Meets set up by their teachers to the best of their ability. Even if your student feels that they do not have questions or need help, if another student asks a clarifying question your student will be exposed to that direct instruction virtually as the teacher explains or expands on lessons taught in the classroom. Teachers offer office hours specifically for students who need extra academic support. Students should be accessing them regularly.
