Dear Parents/Carers,

After School / Lunchtime Football Club Term 2

In the first week of Term 2 we will be running a football club in social time (lunchtime and after-school) for all year groups in separate locations and/or evenings. When football is run in social time (not PE curriculum time), we need to get parental consent.

If you would like your child to play football during social time, you must give your child consent to play. Therefore, if you do not sign the form below your child will not be able to join football club for their age group this academic year.

See information below:

- By completing this form, you are consenting to allow your child to take part in football sessions within Slough and Eton during the Coronavirus pandemic.
- All parents / guardians must fully understand that sessions will involve close contact & accept the risks associated with their child training and playing within this environment.
- We have put a risk assessment in place for the return to football, which follows government guidance and the Football Associations (FA) return to grassroots competitive football. This risk assessment includes that students will sanitise their hands before and after playing football, not touching the ball with their hands and only using their feet, as well as other measures in place.
- Providing your consent for your child to return to play from 2020-21 season onward confirms that you understand the activities being offered to your child and agree with the measures that the club has put in place.
