### IX. COMMITTEES

## 1. <u>Curriculum & Technology Committee</u>

Mrs. Madhukar reported that the Curriculum and Technology Committee met at 12:30 P.M. on August 20, 2020 remotely through ZOOM.

In attendance were: Shivi Madhukar, Beth Moroney, Falguni Patel, Elizabeth Conway, Gail Pawlikowski and Baninder Mahabir

## **Items Discussed:**

- The Committee discussed curriculum revisions for the 2020 School Year. Many of these changes were necessitated by the need to accommodate remote learning resources.
- At the elementary level, this includes changes to ELA, Social Studies, Math, G&T, Technology, Health and Science Integration and Physical Education. It was discussed that since the District was unable to administer an entrance test for G&T because of COVID related school closure, all students will participate in the program.
- The Committee also discussed changes to curriculum guides for the following subjects at the secondary level:
  - Integrated Math B
  - Statistics AP (Accelerated and Academic)
  - Calculus AP (Accelerated and Academic)
  - Algebra 1
  - Physics Honors
  - Chemistry Level 1 and 2
- Introduction to Interior Design. This is a new course offered at the high school level, and it is available to seniors only.
- Tomorrow Teachers: This is also a new course. It is an elective course and will provide resources for attracting, placing and retaining well qualified individuals in the teaching profession. Students will learn fundamentals of education by participating in district-level field experience. The course is also open to seniors only.
  - MS World Language French and Spanish
- MS Dance 1: This is a new course as well. This will provide an introduction to dance. It is an elective course and no previous training is required.
  - AP Capstone
- In addition, the Committee discussed the roll out of touchable chromebooks for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> graders. The delivery has been delayed because of unforeseen reasons.

## 2. <u>Curriculum & Technology Committee</u>

Mrs. Madhukar reported that the Curriculum and Technology Committee met at 2:00 P.M. on August 27, 2020 remotely through ZOOM.

In attendance were: Shivi Madhukar, Beth Moroney, Falguni Patel, Carol Bodofsky, Gail Pawlikowski and Baninder Mahabir

#### Items Discussed:

• The Committee discussed the roll out and details about a new chemistry book for high school students.

### 3. Curriculum & Technology Committee

Mrs. Madhukar reported that the Curriculum and Technology Committee met at 11:30 A.M. on June 12, 2020 remotely through ZOOM.

In attendance were: Shivi Madhukar, Dr. Yunxia Chen, Elizabeth Conway, Bernard F. Bragen, Jr., Ed.D., Ralph Barca, Christopher Conklin, Ed.D., Gail Pawlikowski and Baninder Mahabir

#### Items Discussed:

- Mr. Barca gave an update on technology issues in view of the remote learning environment. The Committee learned that issues are more persistent at the elementary school level. Students with Lenovo chromebooks are facing more issues than those with Dell chromebooks. To address the problem, devices are being swapped as needed. Chromebooks work great in the classroom but there are issues when they are used for distance learning. Some issues were prevalent because of google outages. The Committee discussed using backups such as zoom and webex. In addition, the District had ordered devices earlier in the summer which are going to be delivered on October 14<sup>th</sup>. This should alleviate some of the ongoing issues.
- Login for 7<sup>th</sup> grade Math textbook: Multiple logins were not allowed; hence, some students were not able to access their textbooks. The issue has since been resolved.
- Hybrid roll out from October 19<sup>th</sup>: The District is confident of providing in-person learning for those who choose in-person, unless the State changes existing rules. Although the plans are not finalized yet, the District is hopeful of providing bussing. The Committee discussed ways in which instruction time could be increased without compromising safety. This included discussion on block scheduling. In addition, a survey will be going to parents in the next few weeks asking about their preference for school attendance in MP2 whether they would want their children to study remotely or in person.
- The Committee also discussed sending out another survey to parents to understand issues that are persisting and what is going well, so we can continue to improve experiences of our students.
- The Committee discussed curriculum revisions. This includes Business Management, Family Consumer Science, College Composition and Literature, ELA 6-8 and Career and Vocational Readiness.
- PSAT Administration: Juniors will take it on October 17<sup>th</sup>. It is a Saturday. The test will be administered in person using CDC guidelines. Transportation will be provided to anyone who needs it. PSAT for 8<sup>th</sup> graders will not take place in December. The test will be administered to them in January. No decision has been made whether it will be online or in person. If it is online, the test will not be used for the placement. Finally, 10<sup>th</sup> grade will not be administered PSAT in 2020. The administration will make the decision after the 11<sup>th</sup> Grade PSAT. It is likely that the test may be administered in January 2021. The school district will send out an informational letter as soon as the decision is made.
- Hardcopy Textbooks: The Committee discussed the need for hardcopy textbooks. After being all day on the computer, the students need a break from the screen. The Committee also discussed updating the website with the names of all textbooks for all grades for informational purposes.
- The Committee also discussed the ELA pilot program at the elementary level. The Committee was informed that it is no longer a pilot but in a transition phase. Every teacher is working extremely hard and the District has received positive feedback so far.

### 4. Finance & Facilities Committee

Mrs. Conway reported that the Finance and Facilities Committee met at 4:00 P.M. on September 15, 2020 at the Education Center.

In attendance were: Elizabeth Conway, Ralph Errico, Dr. Yunxia Chen, Shivi Prasad-Madhukar (ZOOM), Bernard F. Bragen, Jr., Ed.D., Daniel P. Michaud and Will Kolibas

#### Items Discussed:

- The Committee discussed the purchase of the smaller thermal monitoring cameras. To attempt to have them funded by the FEMA aid, 14 machines would be ordered by 9/15/20, totaling about \$40,000.
- The District had applied for public assistance for the COVID-19 expenditures. FEMA has provided the application and directions to apply for federal FEMA aid. All COVID-19 expenditures that were not funded by the CARES Act or the Digital Divide funding will be submitted for reimbursement.
- The Committee confirmed their commitment to pay bus contractors 60% of their contract amount for time that the District is providing remote instruction. This is the same percentage that the District agreed to pay last year.
- The Committee discussed the Lincoln School addition that had been allocated in the 2020-2021 budget. The Committee instructed the administration to have the District's architect of record, USA Architects, prepare schematic drawings and a construction budget for the board to consider. The budget currently has about \$6 million available for the project. In the event that the amount exceeds \$6 million, the District's capital reserve account can be used to fund the balance.
- The Committee discussed the cricket pitch at Woodrow Wilson Middle School. Relocation and upgrading was considered. The District may want to initiate adding cricket as an organized sport for the middle and high schools.
- The Committee reviewed the District's current Building Use Policy and Application. The Committee instructed the administration to evaluate the fee schedule to ensure that the District is covering its costs of operating the school during the rental period.
- The Committee discussed the need to increase the technology staff to handle over 20,000 devices that the District currently provides to the staff and students. The administration is proposing an increase of 3 technicians.
- Dr. Bragen proposed a car allowance for the attendance investigators. The attendance investigators use their vehicles extensively in the performance of their duties. The figure that was discussed was \$3,000 annually. Dr. Bragen will discuss the possibility of preparing a sidebar agreement to their contract with the ETEA.

The meeting adjourned at 5:25 P.M.

#### 5. Special Education Committee

Mrs. Conway reported that the Special Education Committee met at 2:00 P.M. on September 17, 2020 remotely through ZOOM.

In attendance were: Elizabeth Conway, Carol Bodofsky, Falguni Patel, Dawn Netzel, Erin Madera, Christopher Conklin, Ed.D.

### Items Discussed:

• The Committee discussed staffing. Self-contained classes are back and all schools except Woodbrook and Lindeneau are housing students.

• Evaluations are 90% up to date. The Committee will update revisions to career and vocational readiness curriculum with future meetings being held November 20, 2020, December 21, 2020, April 21, 2021 and June 21, 2021.

The meeting adjourned at 2:25 P.M.

Mr. Shi questioned remote learning, break times and block scheduling.

Mrs. Conway informed the Board and public that Chartwell's employee, Evelyn Kiss is turning 100 years old on October 15<sup>th</sup>. She also thanked the teachers, students and their parents who all gave a phenomenal effort during this Pandemic.

Mr. Errico expressed his appreciation to all employees in the Edison Board of Education for their efforts during the COVID-19 Pandemic. He also reported that he attended a Herbert Hoover Middle School PTO meeting via Zoom. He was impressed that not one person complained about how things are going so far this year. Their only concern was about how things will develop this school year.

Mrs. Conway welcomed all the new hires.

### XII. PUBLIC COMMENTS

Virginia White, resident, thanked the board for going back to two meetings a month and thanked the IT team for all their hard work. She also suggested that members of each department be present at the meetings to answer any questions from parents.

He also mentioned that he recently attended a Planning Board meeting where they discussed available land in Edison. Mr. Pandya asked the Board to meet with the Planning Board to see if any of this land may be used for the students of Edison.

Ernest Kregeloh, resident, discussed an iPad charging problem and questioned the undisclosed location in each school for students who come to school with temperatures. He does not want to see a student with only a temperature be put in the same room as a student with COVID-19.

Amy Ryan, resident, discussed the remote learning plan approved by the state and also questioned staff training for remote learning.

Bret Baker, resident, asked how the Board communicates the many issues with the families.

Beth Talke, resident, questioned what would happen if staff members came down with COVID-19.
