#### Items Discussed:

- Hybrid Schedule: The committee was presented three options for Hybrid schedules. The change was recommended by a previous day meeting of Return to School Parents' Committee. The committee agreed with the recommendation. It was discussed that if issues persisted, the committee would revisit the schedule for MP2.
- Parent Portal: The committee discussed that prompt updates on parent portal was even more important during the pandemic, especially in regard to tests and quizzes.
- Assessment: The committee discussed the need for uniformity across similar classes in terms of time given to complete assessments. The committee also discussed the need for an optimal ratio between lessons and testing. Finally, the committee acknowledged difficulties in the review of test papers and quizzes by students because of remote setting.
- PSAT 10<sup>th</sup> Grade: It will be administered in January 2021.
- Technology update: There has been further delay in the delivery of chrome books for elementary schools.
- Survey: The committee discussed the need to send out a parent survey to get feedback on the administration of remote teaching.
- Other items discussed included policy regarding dropping a course in high school, three levels for middle school math and placement criteria. No decisions were made.
