PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



Dear Friends,

We are thankful for God's blessings and your partnership in supporting the ministry of Hawaii Baptist Academy. Your prayers and generosity are greatly appreciated as we continue our school's mission to equip

students spiritually, intellectually, physically, socially, and emotionally, so that they bring honor to God.

This year, we faced many challenges due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Through God's grace and provision, these challenges strengthened us as a community. During quarantine, our on-site food vendor, Flik, provided lunch meals for two homeless shelters in Honolulu. Sisters Lydia '21 and Eudoia '24 Lan helped their mother raise more than \$20,000 to purchase N95 face masks for healthcare workers. We were able to successfully finish our fourth quarter of school online, thanks to our dedicated and committed faculty. The pandemic also brought about many "firsts," including our first drive-thru Senior Send-Off, our first virtual baccalaureate service, and our first in-person graduation ceremony (for immediate families only) in the gym at the Stan Sagert High School campus.

Although the fourth quarter may not have been what our students and faculty expected, we saw many notable accomplishments from our students throughout the school year, including:

- the *Eagle Eye* newspaper won Best-In-State for their sixth consecutive year;
- Brendan Aoki '24 took first place overall in the junior division of the Hawaii State Science and Engineering Fair, and also first place overall at the Hawaii Association of Independent Schools' District Science Fair;
- Zach Lau '20 advanced to the finalist round of the National Merit Scholarship Competition;
- Alyssa Young '22 won second place in preliminary judging for the 2020 Ninth Circuit Civics Contest in the district of Hawaii;
- the intermediate and high school Science Olympiad Teams finished first at the Science Olympiad Windward Regional competition;

- Kaycee Nakashima's '20 documentary, "Taiko for the Deaf," was featured on *Hiki No*, PBS Hawaii's weekly student news show. This was the first HBA production to be featured on the show;
- "Irreversible," a short film by Karissa Tabadero '21, was selected for the student showcase at the Hawaii International Film Festival;
- HBA hosted its first Summer Wind Festival, a one-week clinic for high school band students on the island of Oahu;
- Victoria Luk '22 and Mikaela Dukelow '22 both placed in an art contest for Japanese new year postcards. Luk took first place for the comical category, and Dukelow took third place in the Hawaii category;
- the girls cross country team won their state championship for the second year in a row;
- after years of playing in Division 2, the girls volleyball team moved to Division 1;
- the second graders purchased 100 books for homeless preschoolers with money they earned by doing chores at home;
- and the National Honor Society presented a check for \$7,728 to Ho'ola Na Pua, a local non-profit that cares for and rehabilitates girls who have been trafficked. Students donated close to \$6,000 during Spirit Week and NHS members raised the rest through selling Christmas wreaths.

While the future of our world may seem uncertain, we are grateful that our God is the same yesterday, today and tomorrow. It is this assurance that allows us to remain steadfast, as we continue to press on in raising up the next generation of leaders who will serve their communities in the name of Jesus Christ. HBA has been God's school for more than 70 years, and we are confident that if we continue to follow Him, He will carry us through whatever challenges may come our way. Thank you for your continued prayers and financial support, especially during these difficult times. May God continue to bless you and your families.

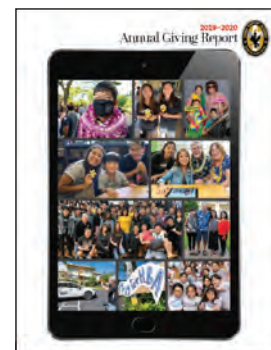

The fund will continue to accept donations as the need continues to grow.

Community Give Back Program



As our island community rallied to support one another during the COVID-19 crisis, Hawaii Baptist Academy (HBA) joined several Hawaii Pacific Baptist Convention (HPBC) churches in providing meals at two homeless shelters in Honolulu. During HBA's campus closure, the school maximized the talents of our hardworking HBA chefs to help others.

A total of **8,000 lunches** were prepared and delivered to Next Step and Keauhou Shelters, serving **200 people** daily, Monday through Friday for eight weeks.

God provided many generous donors, and we raised over **\$25,000** and received over **\$3,000** worth of gifts in kind towards meal preparation.

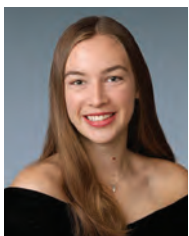

These were the words that described Janel Kam-Magruder '94 when she was named Miss HBA. Today, her servant, Christ-like heart is even more evident. A graduate of DePauw University with a degree in biology, and Loma Linda University School Of Medicine, Kam-Magruder is a practicing family physician with a focus in geriatrics and palliative care. She also serves on the faculty at the Alaska Family Medicine Residency Program in Anchorage, Alaska.

Kam-Magruder shares how HBA prepared her for her career in medicine. "The faculty at HBA supported me in many ways, allowing me to develop both academically and also in my character, leadership and walk with Christ. I believe the education I received prepared me well for the academic rigors of college and medical school. The AP classes I took allowed me to get ahead in college so I could participate in a premedical program while studying abroad so I could widen my experiences in science and medicine."

She recalls countless long nights, studying in the dark, silent cubicles of her college library. She was thankful that she didn't have to take another semester of calculus or physics as she had completed them at HBA. When applying for medical school, she even leaned on her HBA English teachers for advice.



As she reminisced about her experience at HBA, one of her favorite memories was attending grade level camps and developing relationships with her classmates, including Trisha (Fukumoto) Lee, Tyler Tanaka, Alicia (Takushi) Andes and Scott Sunaoka. She recalls sitting on the porch at night with them at the Pu'ukahea Conference Center playing the guitar, singing and just enjoying each other's company. She also loved ministering through music during senior year with the select vocal ensemble, Soldiers of Light, and playing volleyball. She credits both activities for providing her a grounded experience throughout high school.

Kam-Magruder and her family have been living in Alaska for 18 years. Her husband Matthew works as a hospitalist, and they have four children: Amaeli, 15; Noa, 13; Miya, 11; and Elijah, 5 months old. Her three oldest children belong to a K-12 Japanese Immersion program. As a family, they partake in all the outdoor activities Alaska has to offer, especially nordic skiing, downhill skiing, mountain biking, fishing, hunting and hiking.

Their family worships at St. Mary's Episcopal Church where Kam-Magruder and her husband serve as youth group leaders. "Matt and I have taught youth Sunday

school. I am thankful for the experiences I gained at HBA to foster discussion about faith."

"We donate to organizations, HBA being one of them, that have shaped and supported us in life. This school is so much a part of my life. My father, Robert '66 and brother, Jonathan '97 are alumni and my niece currently attends HBA. Our gifts are what we can do to give back to HBA, which has not only influenced my walk with Christ, but has shaped the person I am today."



MAC Spotlight

LURIE WALKER STEWART taught HBA kindergartners for nine years, a total of about 200 children. Now she donates faithfully to the Dr. Edmond Walker and Lurie Walker Stewart Scholarship Endowment Fund at HBA, which has now reached \$86,000. The annual proceeds from this fund are used to provide scholarships to two incoming kindergartners. HBA now has three sections of kindergarten and some of the parents were children Lurie taught.

When Sharon Hagio, from our Advancement office, asked me to write about Lurie, I was delighted. Lurie is my oldest friend. I've known her since I was seven and our lives have connected in many ways. We can share memories no one else can.

Lurie and her husband Edmond Walker moved to California in 1946 to pastor a church in Modesto. About that same time my father became pastor of another church in the Central Valley Baptist Association. The association meetings were held one Saturday a month in a different host church. During the boring business sessions, we little kids were allowed to play outside. But I had started taking music lessons and always came inside for the singing. I would watch admiringly as the beautiful Mrs. Walker played the piano.

In the summer of '47, both Lurie and my mother were expecting babies. So was another pastor's wife, whose baby died. This tragedy bought our three families closer.

In 1949 the Walkers moved to Southern California to a pastorate in El Monte. California Baptist College, now University, had just started in another El Monte church and the Walkers were involved in the school's early days.

In 1960 I graduated from Cal Baptist and headed for Honolulu to teach at HBA. In 1963 Dr. Walker came to be the executive secretary of the Hawaii Baptist Convention and our lives connected again. We would be next door neighbors for a short time and colleagues for a long time.

Lurie recalls that in her 19 years in Hawaii, she lived in five houses, most of them owned by HBA or the Convention. One was across the backyard from where I lived. After the Walkers moved out, that house became the kindergarten and Lurie moved back into what would be her classroom until she retired. Of course besides teaching, she was busy supporting her husband in his duties with the Convention. She was also the accompanist at Olivet Baptist Church.

When Edmond retired, the Walkers moved back to California where he served interim pastorates. The Walkers had remained family friends with Dr. J. Jones Stewart, the attending physician when their second son had been born. Fifty years later, his wife and Edmond died at about the same time. Correspondence and shared grief blossomed into love and five years of marriage.

Lurie, who recently turned 97, lives in San Diego, not far from her younger son, Howard. His brother Rich '65 lives in Texas. Previously she lived in a congenial retirement community near Ventura. She kept the grand piano Dr. Stewart had given her in the assembly room and played for popular sing-alongs and hymn-sings with fellow residents.

A member of the Mainland Advisory Council, Lurie last attended the meeting in 2012, when she got to visit the campuses and reconnect with her many Hawaii friends.

I was a kindergarten drop-out myself, but have made up for it by volunteering as a reading coach for the youngest students. What a joy to know that some of them are there because Lurie keeps giving!

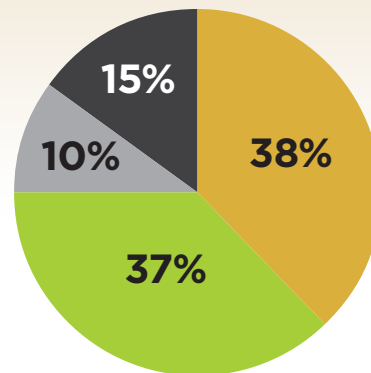

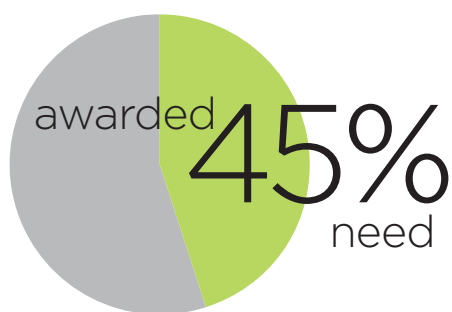

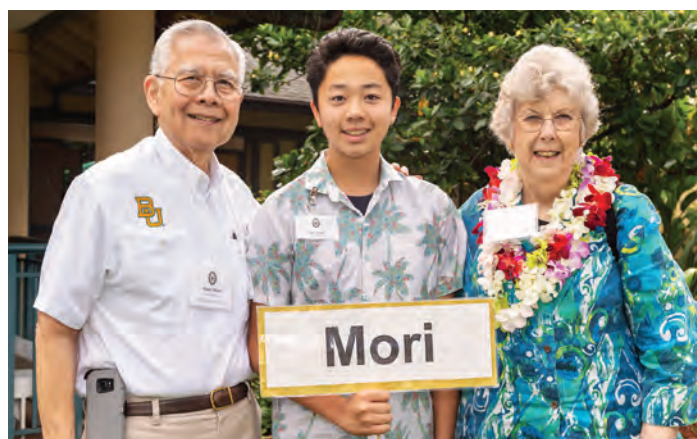
