Board Member Conflict of Interest

No Board member shall have a beneficial interest directly or indirectly in any contract, work, or business of the District unless permitted by state or federal law. Board members are prohibited from participating in the selection, award, or administration of a contract supported by a federal award if they have a real or apparent conflict of interest.

Gifts or unsolicited items must comply with federal law, state law and Board policy 2.105, Ethics and Gift Ban.

Board members must annually file a Statement of Economic Interests as required by the Illinois Governmental Ethics Act. Each Board member is responsible for filing the statement with the county clerk of the county in which the District's main office is located by May 1.
