Second Semester Update 2021

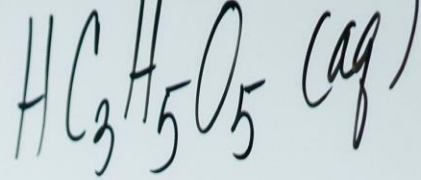




Bishop Kenny High School will continue on-campus learning while following all CDC, state, and local guidelines to ensure the safety and well-being of our students and staff.

Students currently completing coursework via our virtual school may return to on-campus learning beginning January 5, 2021 or remain in the virtual program for the second semester.

*Parents/Guardians of on-campus students may request enrollment in the virtual program for the second semester. To choose this option, the parent/guardian must contact the school counselor by **December 16, 2020**.*

Clean

Deep clean and sanitize all classrooms, common areas, and athletic facilities routinely using appropriate products.

Space student desks in all classrooms as best as possible with seats forward-facing; expand outdoor seating options; ensure social distancing in all common areas.

Face Masks Required

All students, staff, and visitors to campus are required to wear a face mask **at all times**, except during physical activities or when consuming meals.

This policy will remain in effect for the remainder of the 2020-2021 school year unless otherwise announced.



COVID-19 Safety Protocol

- ◆ Teachers are trained to identify symptoms; students presenting any symptoms of illness will be sent to the School Clinic.
- ◆ The school nurse will check the temperature and screen any student or staff member exhibiting symptoms of illness. Any individual with a temperature of 100.4 or higher or presenting symptoms will be isolated until he/she can be sent home.
- ◆ Students returning to school from **any illness** will have a temperature check prior to returning to class.



COVID-19 Safety Protocol

- ◆ Any student or staff member suspected of having COVID-19 or reporting exposure to COVID-19 **must self-quarantine at home.**
- ◆ Bishop Kenny High School will follow the COVID-19 Case Reporting procedures set forth by the Office of the Superintendent for the Diocese of St. Augustine.
- ◆ Distance learning options will be offered to any student who must self-quarantine.
- ◆ A student's or staff member's return to school is determined by the COVID-19 reporting protocol of the Diocese of St. Augustine.

Routine Procedures

- ◆ Administrators, faculty, and staff will be on supervision during arrival, changing of classes, and dismissal to ensure compliance with face mask and distancing policies.
- ◆ All guests to our campus must also wear a face mask; non-essential visitors will be limited.
- ◆ Food deliveries from vendors will not be accepted.
- ◆ Students and teachers will use **e-Hallpass**, a contact-less hall pass system that will limit the number of persons in the restrooms and hallways during class time.

Meal Service and Seating

- ◆ Table spacing and capacity limits inside the Cafeteria/Harris Center and on all outside courtyards will remain in effect to promote social distancing during meals.
- ◆ Chartwells, our food service vendor, will continue to provide “grab and go” meal options in the Cafeteria.

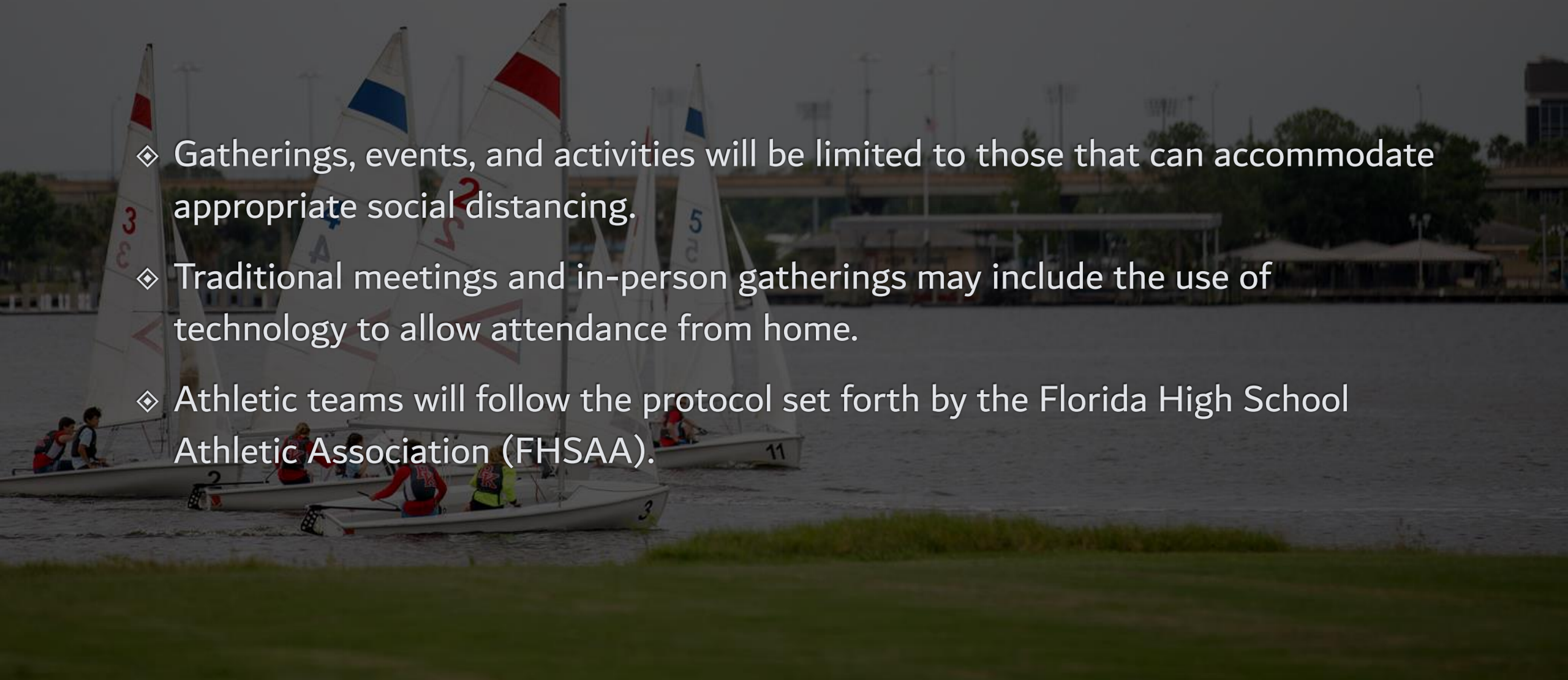
Transportation

The following procedures will continue to be in effect:


- ◆ All BKHS buses will be thoroughly sanitized during the school day in between routes. Drivers will also sanitize all surfaces at the end of the day.
- ◆ Students and drivers will be required to wear **face masks** on the bus since social distancing may not be possible.
- ◆ Drivers will scan each student's temperature before boarding the bus in the morning. Any student with a 100.4 or higher temperature may not board.
- ◆ All BKHS buses are ventilated with dual air conditioning systems; filters are cleaned routinely.
- ◆ Third-party transportation (field trips and athletics) will follow separate procedures to ensure student health and safety.

Activities & Athletics

- ◆ Gatherings, events, and activities will be limited to those that can accommodate appropriate social distancing.
- ◆ Traditional meetings and in-person gatherings may include the use of technology to allow attendance from home.
- ◆ Athletic teams will follow the protocol set forth by the Florida High School Athletic Association (FHSAA).



Physical Education Classes



- ◆ Students will wear masks at all times in the locker rooms, with the exception of showering.
- ◆ Instructors will stagger class activities to provide adequate social distancing.
- ◆ Instructors will implement additional sports-specific procedures as they pertain to the scheduled activities.

Continuity of Learning and Planning for Academic Growth



The **Instructional Continuity Plan** adopted for the 2020-2021 school year remains in effect, offering options for **distance learning** should a school closure be necessary.



The Office of School Counseling and Academic Department continue to monitor student progress and achievement.



Plan A – On-Campus Learning

- ◆ We will follow the normal school schedule and routines with distancing and COVID-19 safety procedures in place.
- ◆ Students who must **self-quarantine** due to exposure or suspicion of COVID-19 may continue classes via **distance learning**, including attending class **remotely** via video conferencing (Zoom). This option is only available for those under the self-quarantine protocol.
- ◆ NOTE: The length of self-quarantine is determined in accordance with the guidelines of the Florida Department of Health and the Office of the Superintendent of Schools for the Diocese of Saint Augustine.



Plan B

Brief School Closure (2-3 days)

Should there be a need for a brief school closure, the following **synchronous learning schedule** will take place:

- ◇ All students will follow the **normal bell schedule** for the day.
- ◇ Students must join class **remotely** at the scheduled time for virtual instruction. Instruction will be a minimum of 20 minutes, but may extend longer based on the nature of the lesson/discipline.
- ◇ Attendance will be recorded by class period.



Plan C

Extended School Closure (2-3 weeks)

Should there be a need for an extended school closure, Bishop Kenny will adopt a **rotational virtual instruction schedule (synchronous learning)**:

If PLAN C is implemented, we will provide detailed guidelines to parents and students.
