# FREE INTERNET FOR ELIGIBLE FAMILIES



**Reliable connectivity** to the internet is critical for student success during remote teaching and learning. The state recognizes this need and has partnered with Ziply Fiber, Comcast/Xfinity and Presidio to create <u>Washington's K-12 Internet Access Program</u>, which gives eligible families free internet access so students can connect to online learning from home.

This internet access opportunity will potentially provide families with faster and more reliable connectivity than hotspots, which will better support our students. Eligible families can receive free internet access through June 30, 2021.

If students have not taken a school ID photo and their senior photo does not meet the requirements listed above, they will not be pictured in the yearbook.

## **TECH HELP AT RHS**



When having software issues, students should still contact <a href="mailto:ftaccess@lwsd.org">ftaccess@lwsd.org</a> or phone 425-936-1322 for the Family Technology Access support line.

Two recent and crucial service improvements for families include offering an **automated call back and/or automated VM to ticket options** to the Family Technology Access line as well as **language interpretive services** during our 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. hours of support 7 days a week.

**However, for hardware issues,** Redmond High offers in-person tech help.

To access this service, use the driveway east of the main entrance, labeled *Deliveries and Staff Only*. Park your car next to the sign for the library, and wearing a mask, walk up to the back door of the library. Note: this is an outdoor service, so *come dressed for the weather*. We are open from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m., Monday - Friday.
