College - Levels of Service



- **Program - Maximum Support**

- Fee for services, separate application, degree seeking, documentation required, trained staff
 - Southern Illinois University (ACHIEVE)
 - University of Arizona (SALT)
 - University of Denver (LEP)
 - University of Wisconsin-Whitewater (Project Assist)
 - University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh (Project Success) - non-fee
 - Muskingum College (PLUS)
 - Edgewood College - (Cutting Edge) -degree & non-degree option

College - Levels of Service



- **Comprehensive Support Services - Medium Support**

- May require additional fees, no separate application, student responsible for arranging accommodations
 - Arizona State University
 - Illinois State University
 - Loyola University Chicago
 - Michigan State University
 - University of Missouri
 - Carthage College
 - Colgate University
 - Davidson College
 - Emerson College
 - Oberlin College

College - Levels of Service



- **Student Services/Accommodation - Mandated Support**

- Most require no fee, documentation still required, student must self-advocate to access support and accommodations
