RE: *Limited-time mitigation orders and sports*

On Thursday, December 10, 2020, [Governor Tom Wolf](#) and [Secretary Dr. Rachel Levine](#) announced new, limited-time mitigation orders that take effect at 12:01am on December 12, 2020 and remain in effect until 8:00am on January 4, 2021.

K-12 School Sports and Youth Sports

All sports at K-12 public schools, nonpublic schools, private schools and club, travel, recreational, intermural, and intramural sports are paused.

All PENNCREST schools and facilities are closed to all in-season, out-of-season, youth, and similar teams and organizations for practices, workouts, games, events, open-gyms and similar during the limited-time mitigation orders. Lastly, all PENNCREST affiliated coaches, captains, players and volunteers are not permitted to organize off campus practices, workouts, games, events, open gyms or similar.

Pennsylvania Orders, Guidance & Recommendations

On July 15, 2020, Governor Tom Wolf and Secretary of Health Dr. Rachel Levine signed [orders for targeted mitigation](#) efforts in response to the rise in COVID cases. The new orders took effect at 12:01 a.m., Thursday, July 16, 2020. Information related to [spectators at school athletic events](#) was updated on September 2, 2020. On November 17, 2020, The Secretary of health issued an additional [face covering](#) and [travel](#) orders. [Pre-K to 12 \(PK-12\) school sports](#) under the Pennsylvania Interscholastic Athletic Association (PIAA) and the Pennsylvania Independent Schools Athletic Association (PISAA) must follow the [PDE Preliminary Guidance for Phased Reopening of Pre-K to 12 Schools](#) and the [CDC Considerations for Youth Sports](#). December 10, 2020 [limited-time mitigation orders](#).
