District Personalized Competency Based-Learning Presentation (Christi Blankman)

- The purpose of the discussion was to engage councils in the development of the Davis Learner Profiles. The profiles will provide target outcomes for work in curriculum, social-emotional learning, professional development, and personalized competency-based learning
- Our discussion was a profile of 9th graders and the profile topic: Critical Thinkers

Counseling Report-(Mr. Plant)

- Council question regarding number of “F” grades in 1st term
In 2020 there were 151 “F”s in 1st term. In 2019 there were 138 “F”s in 1st term
There are eight 9th grade students that are credit deficient
- We offer students credit recovery through online, base camp, work with teacher, administration and counselors.
- Jumpstart program will begin December 11, 2020. This program allows students to work with core teachers each Friday, from 8:30-11:30 a.m. Notification will be sent through email to parent and note to student inviting them to attend. Jumpstart program will continue to the end of the school year.
- Counselor’s / SBO’s are coordinating with Sub for Santa. We currently have six CJH families we are assisting.
- College Night will not be held this year. Counselors will send out an email informing parents of electronic resources in regards to Colleges and Universities. Counselors have been talking with students in their Social Studies class.
- 2nd Semester class schedule changes will be same as 1st semester. Online scheduler will be open after Christmas break. Class changes will be done via phone or email. Appointments will be the first 3 Fridays after winter break.
