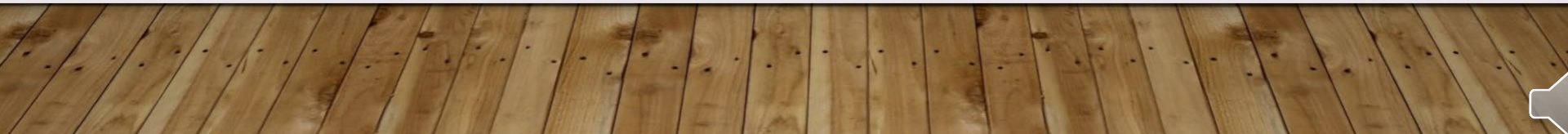

ADVANCED COURSES

- Good idea to challenge yourself with advanced classes, but think very carefully about these yearlong commitments
 - **Talk to your current teachers!**
- Pay attention to homework requirements
 - example: World Language recommends you spend 45 minutes a night to properly prepare for the class
- Evaluate your other commitments
 - clubs, athletics, family, work, volunteering, spiritual, etc.

REMINDERS!

- Think very carefully about course selections.
- It is very difficult to adjust schedules in the fall because any class changes are subject to space availability.



FALL SCHEDULE ADJUSTMENT PROCESS

- Students receive final schedules on the first day of school
- Follow schedule for first 2 days of school
 - If students have “See Counselor,” are missing a period, or have two classes scheduled at same time, they need to come to the Counseling Center to select a class
- At end of second day, students may download a Schedule Adjustment Request form and follow the directions on the form
- If necessary, counselors will balance classes at beginning of the second week of the semester
