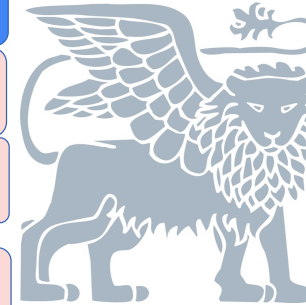


Each course is allotted 3 x 40 minutes, as well as one 40 minute alternate block to use flexibly depending on the class roster. Classes will meet 2x synchronously, with an additional synchronous session or asynchronous "due date" for assignments where faculty are available to support if needed. This **remote schedule** will be in use whenever the campus is closed for in-person learning. All coursework and school activities will take place remotely.
