- **graduation before 2010**, may be living or deceased
- **demonstrated the highest standards in his/her chosen vocation including:**

 - Excellence in his/her vocation and/or avocation
 - Integrity
 - Dedication
 - A retired teacher/administrator at Amity Regional School District No.5 that has fostered and created a love of education
 - Demonstration of living out the Amity District Mission Statement:

To enable every Amity student to become a lifelong learner and a literate caring, creative, and effective world citizen.

- Current and former members of the Amity community may submit one or more nominations each year on the approved nominating form.
- Up to one retired teacher or an administrator may be selected for induction each year.
- Nominations must be in writing, signed, and supported by details supporting the contributions of the candidate to the community and/or to society.

 Award recipients will be chosen from the fields of: Business/Finance, Fine/Performing Arts, Education, Health/Medical Services, Government/Public Service, and Science/Technology.
Recipients will be honored at a ceremony at 5:00 pm on Thursday, October 21, 2021, at the Grassy Hill Country Club in Orange, CT
