

Addendum 3

Answers to questions received and additional scope of service information

- Maps show competition sports fields included in the marked area. Are they included? Do they have the same requirements as the general ground areas? **MISD takes care of the turf fields. The one natural grass field located at MHS is also managed by MISD Operations staff.**
- What type of maintenance is being performed during November thru February? Will the district be maintaining beds, leaf removal and occasional mowing if needed during the winter months? **District will be taking care of these needs. If there are areas that need to be serviced by the awarded vendor, communication will originate from our Maintenance Coordinator for service.**
- No chemical weed removal will be allowed in flower beds. Will a Pre-emergent application be allowed after mechanical removal? **Yes**
- Will cracks, parking lots and fence lines be allowed to be sprayed with a herbicide? **Yes this is allowable, however State School Pesticide Law regulations should be adhered to and documented.**
- Can storage space or overnight parking of enclosed trailers with equipment be provided? **No.**
- Does the district apply pre- and post-emergent weed control on turf areas? **District maintains the turf areas, unless specified by the MISD IPM Coordinator.**

Additional Scope for each mow: IRRIGATION VALVE BOXES

Trim, edge or weedeat around irrigation valve boxes on properties.

Caution/Care to be taken when mowing properties – be mindful of the irrigation valve boxes and do not mow over the areas.
