WAIVER AND RELEASE



The Rockford School District, Burpee Museum of Natural History, Discovery Center Museum, Rockford Boys and Girls Club, Rockford Park District, Severson Dells, YMCA, and other agencies who may provide ASAP @ RPS program and are committed to conducting its recreation programs and activities in a safe manner and hold the safety of participants in high regard. We continually strive to reduce such risks and insists that all participants follow safety rules and instructions designed to protect the participants' safety. However, participants and parents/guardians of minors registering for this program/activity must recognize that there is an inherent risk of injury when choosing to participate in recreational activities/programs. You are solely responsible for determining if you or your minor child/ward are physically fit and/or skilled for the activities contemplated by this agreement. It is always advisable, especially if the participant is pregnant, disabled in any way or recently suffered an illness, injury or impairment, to consult a physician before undertaking any physical activity.

WARNING OF RISK

Recreational activities are intended to challenge and engage the physical, mental and emotional resources of each participant. Despite careful and proper preparation, instruction, medical advice, conditioning and equipment, there is still a risk of serious injury when participating in any activity. Understandably, not all hazards and dangers can be foreseen. Depending on the particular activity, participants must understand the certain risks, dangers and injuries due to inclement weather, slipping, falling, poor skill level or equipment, inadequate supervision, instruction or officiating, and all other circumstances inherent to indoor and outdoor activities exist. In this regard, it must be recognized that it is impossible for the Rockford School District, Burpee Museum of Natural History, Discovery Center Museum, Rockford Boys and Girls Club, Rockford Park District, Severson Dells, YMCA, and other agencies who may provide ASAP @ RPS program and other agencies who may be involved to guarantee absolute safety.

WAIVER AND RELEASE OF ALL CLAIMS AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

By enrolling your child for the 21st CCLC after school program you agree to pick up your child as soon as possible if a staff member calls to inform you that your child is feeling ill. The after-school program will be following the same protocols as the district as outlined on pages 19-20 of the Back-to-School Family Handbook. Signs of the following will result in a phone call being made to pick up your child from the program:

- Have a temperature at or above 100.4 degrees
- Have any of the following symptoms: Fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or running nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea.

Students and staff who display symptoms at school or fit these criteria will be sent home or must be picked up by a parent or guardian. RPS 205 is following advice from the Illinois Department of Public Health. All students and staff who are sent home with COVID-19 symptoms should be diagnostically tested and remain home from school until they receive negative test results for COVID19. 21st CCLC personnel will communicate with school administration regarding any student displaying the above symptoms and families should contact the home school before returning to school. **Failure to pick up your child when displaying the above symptoms will result in the child being dropped from the program.**
