Gingerbread House Collage

Art Elements: Geometric shapes, value, space
Art Ideas: Guided drawing, perspective, "medium"-what you use to create your art with. Crayons and markers make this a "mixed-media" project. Cut & paste items. "Collage"- French word "coller" means to paste.

YOU WILL NEED THE FOLLOWING SUPPLIES:

- 2 pieces white 8.5x11 copy paper
- pencil + eraser
- crayons-brown, 3 greens, light and dark blue
- additional colored crayons
- markers-black, brown, green, light blue
- additional colored markers
- scissors
- glue stick
- Larger paper or newspaper to protect desk/table
- Print "Gingerbread House Ideas" page or view online

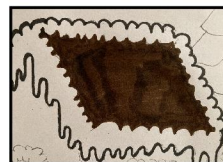
SET-UP DETAILS

- Table height where artist can change position from sitting to standing while creating
- Larger piece of paper/newspaper underneath to protect desk/table if color over edges of paper
- If artist is right-handed, all supplies positioned to the right of the papers, if left-handed please switch all supplies to the right hand side.

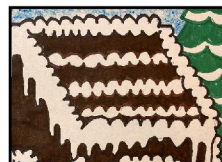
The video has slides that might prompt you to stop/pause the video and follow the instructions on the slide to either gather supplies or follow a series of steps.

Additional Notes on coloring the gingerbread house:

- For the roof, you can omit any icing and just color in that area with brown marker.
- If you include icing, you will trace around that icing in brown and color around it OR if you included curved tiles, I will show you how to color it in so there appears to be icing.



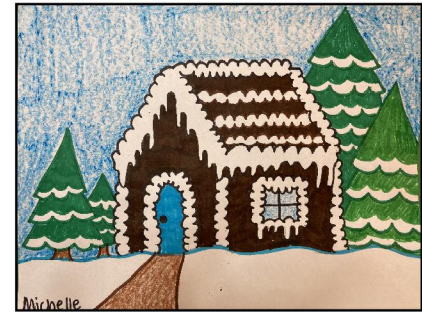
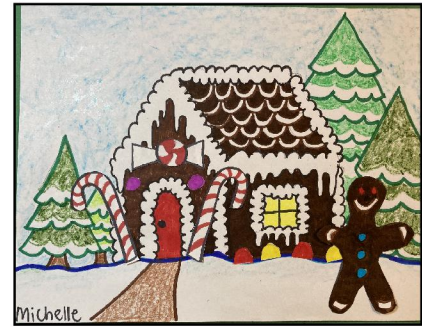
No icing



Simple Icing

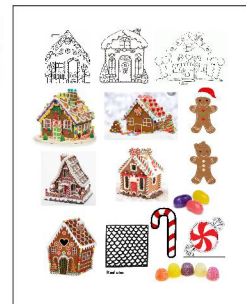


Icing "tiles"
