A. CALL TO ORDER

Chairperson Hennen called the meeting to order at 6:01pm. All board members were in attendance including Amy Hennen, Tony Easter, Amy Wheaton, Michael Kreun, John Stroebel, Marilyn Forsberg and Sarah Bowe, along with Superintendent Jeff Ronneberg. All people attending wore masks and physical distancing was in place.

B. AGENDA APPROVAL

Motion by Easter, seconded by Wheaton, to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried unanimously with all members voting yes. (7-0)

C. DISCUSSION ITEMS

1. 2020-2021 Learning Models Update – Dr. Jeff Ronneberg, Superintendent of Schools, Dr. Hope Rahn, Director of Learning and Innovation, Mr. Tony Mayer, Director of Student Services and Special Education, Ms. Erika Taibl, Director of Communication and Marketing, shared an update on planning taking place for the state mandated shift to the Extended Flexible Learning (EFL) model for secondary students, grades 7-12, based on the number of state reported COVID cases in Anoka County. Highlights of the discussion included updates and discussion on state statistics and recent meetings with MDE and MDH, professional learning and preparation opportunities for staff this week and the first three days of next week, what EFL will look like for secondary students currently in the modified (hybrid) learning model, opportunities for identified students to continue learning in the modified(hybrid) learning model, athletics and activities, transportation, meals for students, and communication to families and staff. Board member questions, discussion, and feedback took place.

2. 2021-2022 School Calendar Process Update – Dr. Ronneberg and Mr. Mayer shared the 2021-2022 draft school calendar, noting that the board, as well as the calendar review team, has seen and reviewed this draft back in fall of 2019. Board questions and comments followed. The proposed draft will be up for approval at the November school board meeting.

3. Other – no other topics were discussed.

Motion by Forsberg, seconded by Easter, to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried unanimously with all members voting yes. (7-0) Meeting adjourned at 7:24pm.
