Frequently Asked Questions

When can I start the application process?

On February 1, 2021. First, enroll your child at his/her home school. Once enrollment is completed, please contact the home school secretary to request an Intradistrict Attendance Release Permit Application.

When will I be notified if my child's permit was approved?

Approval notification will be sent via email once space availability is determined and notifications may occur on a rolling basis during the months of February through the first week of school. **Please ensure that you have completed the enrollment and registration paperwork with your home school of residence while you are waiting notification regarding your permit request.**

Do I need to renew my release permit every school year?

No, once an Intradistrict Permit has been granted, your child is not required to reapply annually.

How do I appeal if Wiseburn denies my release permit?

If the permit is denied, you have the right to appeal the decision, in writing, within 20 calendar days from the date of the denial to the Wiseburn Unified School District Superintendent/Designee at agalindo@wiseburn.org.
