The Cooper Experience

Cooper High School prepares students through the International Baccalaureate Middle Years Programme (IBMYP), Advancement Via Individual Determination (AVID) program and the IB Diploma Programme for responsible citizenship in a global community. Cooper also offers Advanced Placement (AP) courses and a four year STEM program.

IBMYP provides students with a broad base of knowledge, an international perspective and critical thinking skills. It is school-wide for all students in 9th and 10th grades, with an honors component for interested students. Students are offered a continuous IB path from kindergarten through grade 12 via Lakeview Elementary, Robbinsdale Middle School and Cooper.



What distinguishes the IBMYP is its unique core: six global contexts, Approaches to Teaching and Learning Skills, Action and Service, and Key and Related Concepts. The program culminates with the 10th grade Personal Project, where students explore a topic of interest and produce a product of their choosing.

AVID is a 9-12 grade college readiness elective course designed to help students in the academic middle—especially those who will be the first in their family to attend college—prepare for and succeed in college. AVID supports research-based methods for instruction and motivation to succeed. Teachers use AVID strategies building-wide at Cooper.



Outstanding Curriculum

Following IBMYP, the curriculum in grades 11 and 12 is based on state standards, a variety of elective choices, and college-level course offerings in the IB Diploma Programme in the following areas—English, History, Business and Management, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, French and Spanish and Math (three levels available).
