

## SPRING SEMESTER 2020-21 IMPORTANT DATES FOR JANUARY RETURN (revised 1/3/21)

January 11	Quiet period officially begins; all members of the community limit their risk of virus exposure for <u>at least 10 days</u> leading up to campus return
January 13	Deadline for families to submit decision for in-person or remote learning option
January 13–15	All boarding and day students undergo <i>first</i> round of COVID-19 PCR testing at a facility close to home; results must be submitted to Health Center by January 20 (rapid antigen test results will not be accepted)
	Local area students have the option to have their <i>first</i> PCR test administered by Canterbury's Health Center; costs will be billed through insurance/at family's expense
	January 127:00–9:00 PMJanuary 139:00–11:00 AM
January 18	Martin Luther King Jr. Day programming (details to be announced); kick-off of Social Justice Series
January 19 - 20	Day students undergo <u>second</u> round of PCR testing; students have the option to test at a facility close to home or on campus through Canterbury's Health Center offered (in the library) on the following schedule:
	January 19 7:00–9:00 PM January 20 9:00–11:00 AM
January 20	Results of <i>first</i> PCR testing due to Health Center
	Boarding students (domestic and international) return to campus and proceed directly to the library upon arrival; move-in hours between 9:00 AM–4:00 PM
	Second round of PCR testing for boarding students administered upon arrival
	Quarantine period begins for all students and remains in effect until results of <u>second</u> PCR tests are returned; boarding students quarantine on campus, and day students quarantine at home
January 21-22	Spring semester begins with remote access for all students
January 24	Results of <u>second</u> PCR test must be received by Health Center; day students who opted to have second test administered at an off-campus facility must submit results before end of day
	Quarantine will be extended for any student whose test results are delayed
January 25	First day of in-person classes scheduled to begin
January 29	All boarding and day students undergo <i><u>third</u> round of PCR testing; no quarantine required while awaiting results</i>
February 1 (week of)	Surveillance testing protocol begins
