



TRANSITION TO ONLINE LEARNING 2020-21

The following is an overview of ISB's transition plan, should the government mandate full or partial campus closure. In the event that a COVID-19 case is identified in our community, contact tracing will determine which grade levels/divisions are required to transition to online learning.

DAY 1

FACULTY

Professional learning day which includes:

- All faculty workshop to facilitate reflection, clarify expectations and develop team working agreements
- Social Emotional Learning (SEL) workshop
- Planning time
- Optional drop-in sessions for supporting the use of Teams
- Asynchronous support materials including online learning guides, Teams, Seesaw and DX

*This day will run with some modifications should a grade level or division be required to transition to

- Adjusted Wednesday Professional Development (PD) schedule to account for faculty needs
- Digital walk-throughs
- Seek feedback from faculty at regular intervals and adapt systems and structures as needed
- Resume Wednesday update from Office of Learning (OOL)

PARENTS

Communication of campus closure including an overview of the offerings for the following parent education day

Parent education day includes:

- Video message from the Head of School (HOS)
- Principal Coffees
- Two workshops (Elementary and Secondary) led by Dr. Jennifer Wathall on Setting Your Child up for Success for Online Learning
- Drop in support for online learning platforms (Teams/ Seesaw/DX)
- Webpage launch that includes a range of resources to support families
- New support material provided every two weeks via the webpage
- Additional parent sessions led by Dr. Jennifer Wathall (as needed)
- Seek feedback from parent community at regular intervals and adapt systems and structures as needed

STUDENTS

If permitted, a coordinated time will allow for students to attend campus to collect necessary materials and resources. Elementary students to collect their education "go-bag".

Secondary students will receive communication through DX:

- Explanation of the schedule and details on how to connect to Teams meetings
- Support material for managing time effectively, and tips to help online learning

Elementary School:

- Choice boards shared with Homeroom
- Seek feedback at regular intervals

Secondary School:

- SEL content created and shared from counselors
- Targeted mentoring lessons
- DX posts to share additional support materials
- Seek feedback a regular intervals
