

ENGLISH: First Sunday of every month @ 2PM

Communion and Confirmation require 2 years of preparation in order to receive the Sacrament.

Holy Matrimony - A date cannot be set until all requirements are met. You should schedule to meet with our priest at least 8–10 months prior to expected wedding date.




