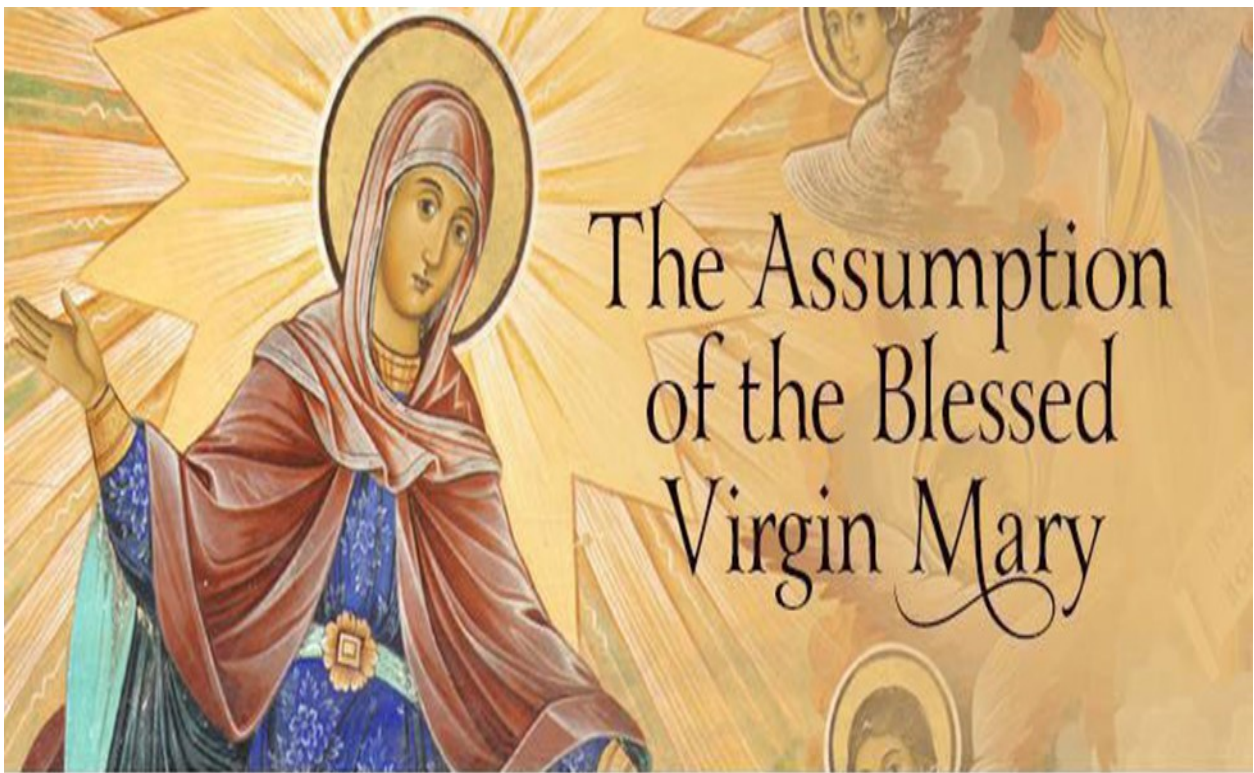

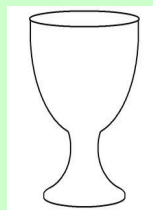

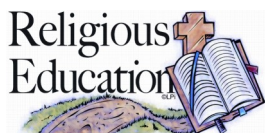

A Responsible Voter is an Informed Voter

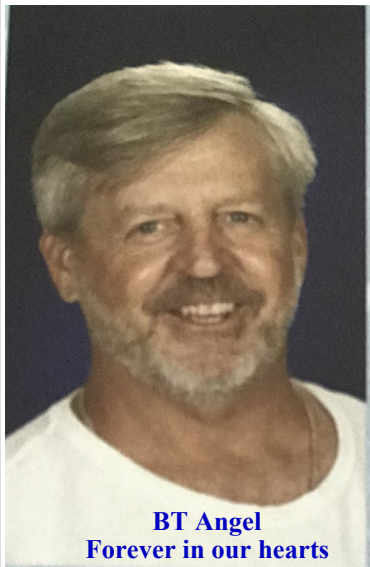
Each election cycle, the Florida Conference of Catholic Bishops (FCCB) conducts the Candidate Questionnaire Project in an effort to assist Catholics and the broader community with the obligation to become informed voters. The FCCB has invited all 2020 U.S. Congressional and Florida Legislative candidates on the ballot in the Primary and General Elections to share their positions on ten public policy issues concerning human life and dignity and the common good. Candidates are offered the opportunity to state their positions as well as provide optional comments on each question.

The Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, August 18. Vote-by-mail is already underway. Early voting begins in some Florida counties as early as Monday, August 3 and statewide on Saturday, August 8. Early voting locations and times are available through the [Division of Elections](#) or by checking with your [county Supervisor of Elections](#).
