

Dear Blessed Trinity Family,

I am very excited to announce that I am in the final phase of working towards my Eagle rank. As a Life Scout from Boy Scout Troop 334 in Miami Springs, both Blessed Trinity and Boy Scouts have been a part of my family for many years. We are parishioners of BT, my father is our Troop's Scoutmaster, my grandfather was an Eagle Scout, and I have been in Scouting for 10 years. Throughout this time, Scouting taught me many skills, including personal management, how to be self-sufficient, and CPR; but most importantly, it has taught me leadership skills and how to give back to the community. Scouts that want to become an Eagle Scout must develop, plan, fundraise, guide and provide leadership to others in a service project that will help a not-for-profit organization in their community.

We know that *Blessed Trinity Catholic Church and School* is an important, charitable and supportive member of our Miami Springs/Virginia Gardens community, and has been since the 1950's. This is why they were chosen as the beneficiary of my Eagle project. The project includes the design, build and installation of a dumpster enclosure to create a safer environment, and to help to enhance the overall aesthetics of the area.

As I move towards the next step in my project's process, fundraising allows me to raise the funds and any material donations needed to start the project. The project's budget of approximately \$1,850 includes both the costs of materials needed to build the large wooden enclosure, and the purchase and installation of the 16 foot x 5 foot metal gate. Please know that if any money remain unused after the project is finished, the money will go directly to Blessed Trinity, the project's beneficiary.

Most people do not know that only about 4% of Boy Scouts earn their Eagle rank, which is mainly because of the high standards needed for Eagle rank consideration. With the help of community members like yourself, I am sure I will soon be a part of that 4%.


