






CRS Rice Bowl 2020 **Collection Information** during COVID-19

Our Church will re-open, Tuesday May 26th! We are very excited to welcome you all back!

Please keep in mind that things will be different for a while, as we adapt to the new regulations. We are still required to maintain social distancing.

We have done everything we can to make sure we are ready. Church has been cleaned and disinfected and will be disinfected after every Mass. We are opening with a maximum capacity of 25%, so seating will be different. Please look out for instructions and schematics that will be emailed early next week.

We ask for your patience and your help in helping us adapt to this new temporary normal.

Our Staff and Welcome Ministers have spent a lot of time going through the logistics and best policies to keep us all safe while still able to be together again.

Here are some things to keep in mind:

- 1- Everyone should be wearing their Masks. Don't forget to bring yours with you.
 Masks should be worn at all times. At time of communion, you would just lower it to consume the body of Christ.
- 2- We encourage you to wash your hands before coming. Bathroom use is limited and only one person at a time allowed.
- 3– We will have Sanitizing stations available upon entry and exit of Church
- 4— Try to get there before Mass time to allow time for proper seating. Remember there is limited seating (25%) and then there will be overflow seating available in the parish hall as needed.
- 5– Upon exiting the church, please listen for the instructions.
- 6– Do not leave gloves or your mask in your seat.
- 7– Please do not congregate by the church. We need to seat people as fast as possible and at time of leaving, we need to move out as quickly as possible as rows are called, so we maintain our distance.
- 8—We need to clean the church after every Mass, so time is limited!

We are looking for volunteers to help with the cleaning in between masses, if you are interested and can help, please call the office.
