After the funeral, when concerned relatives and friends have gone back to their normal lives, your grief continues and you feel very alone. Often friends and family want to help but do not know how. That is the reason for GriefShare. The Blessed Trinity group is led by caring people who have experienced loss and grief and have rebuilt their lives. They understand how you feel because they have been in the same place. Our leaders here will walk with you on the long path through grief, recovery, and healing to find the new normal in your life. You have to go through the grief process in order to heal.

Our Blessed Trinity support group will meet weekly, beginning **Sunday, September 8 from 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm in the Blessed Trinity School library.**
