### Father Yamil's Going Away Party



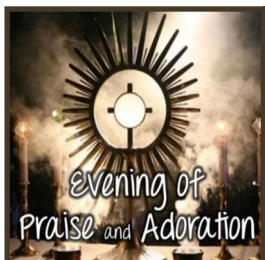
It is hard to say farewell to our dear Fr. Yamil, but knowing how much he loves to party, we invite all of you to join us for his going away party!
