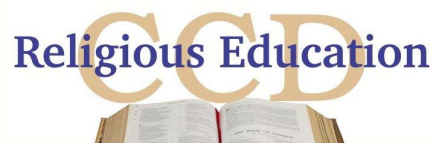

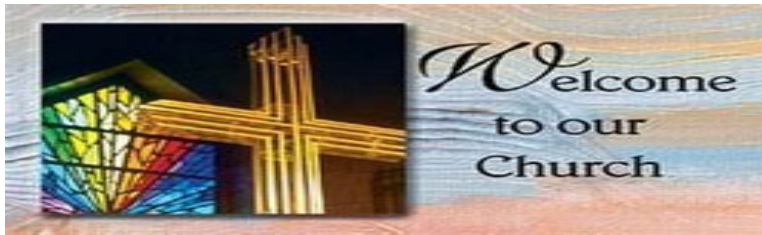
First Saturday of the Month

- ◆ A dar la bienvenida a todos nuestros hermanos y hermanas sin ninguna distinción

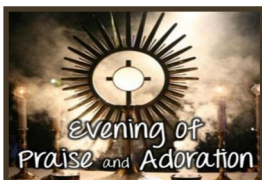
