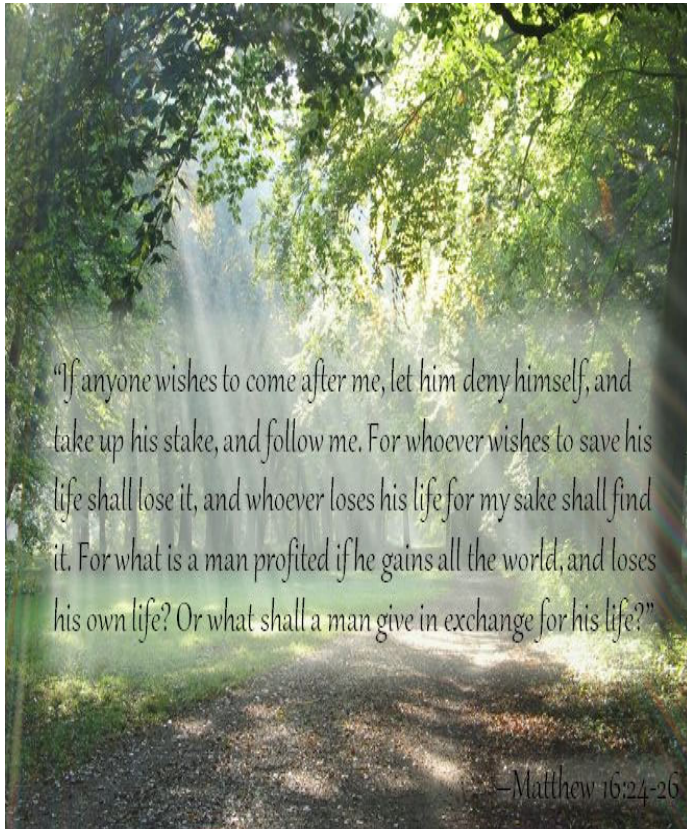

Did you know.....



Why so many Catholics treasure the sacrament of Reconciliation?

The peace of mind and soul which this sacrament imparts to us is one for which there is no substitute. It is a peace that flows from a **certainty**, rather than from an unsure hope, that our sins have been forgiven and that we are right with God.

According to Catholic theology, the sacrament of Penance / Reconciliation is the only ordinary way for the forgiveness of mortal sins committed after Baptism. Although many Catholics initially fear it, they quickly come to love the sacrament of Reconciliation once they get over their nameless fears—fears which come from a misconception of what the sacrament really is.

According to the Code of Canon Law, Catholics are obliged to confess their sins to a priest through the Sacrament of Reconciliation, at least once a year! In the sacrament of Reconciliation we simply give God a chance to share with *us* the infinite merits of his Son. “Your sins are forgiven.” Luke 5:20

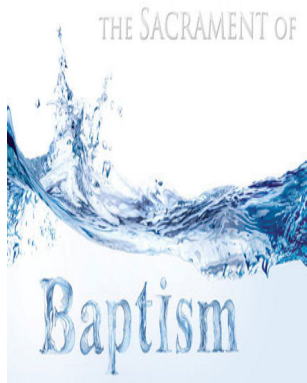

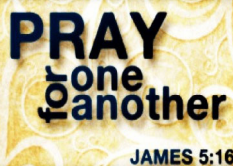

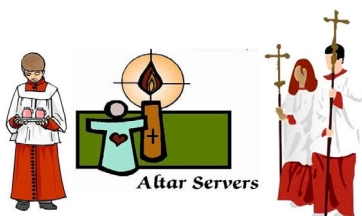
The Parish Office will be closing on Saturdays beginning **September 9th**. We will remain open on Sundays from 9am - 2pm

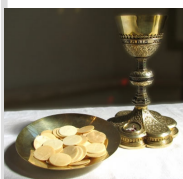
Message from the Archbishop

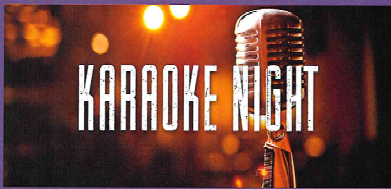

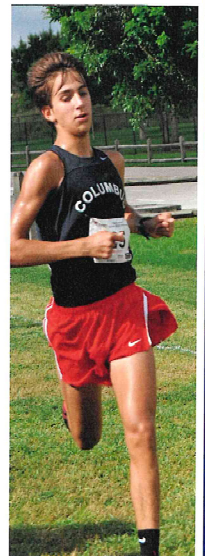
