Dear Parents,

A mandate from the UHSAA requires that a physical examination be performed <u>each school year</u>. This means that you need to schedule an appointment *now* to have that exam done by a physician and the Physical Exam Form A completed, signed, and submitted by February 10. If your student participated in a fall or winter sport, we already have your form on file and there is no need to submit another.

Several other forms are also required and will be read and E-signed by you and your son as you register him for Boys Soccer on the UHSAA site called "**Aktivate**" (formerly "Register My Athlete"), that procedure outlined in another attachment to this email. **Registration on the "Aktivate" site needs to be done by February 10 or before.** All forms except for the Physical Exam and Consent Form will now be **electronically signed by you and your student.**

Our schedule and some other boys' soccer related information can be found through your Parent Portal.

A required **Parent Meeting** via Zoom will be held on **Monday, February 13 at 6:30 p.m.,** a link to that meeting to be sent later.
