Spring Lake Park Schools Co-Curricular Activities After-School Transportation Options Extended Flexible Learning (distance learning)

Because we are currently in Extended Flexible Learning (distance learning) the following are the transportation options for Spring Lake Park student-athletes for school facility practices, home contests, away contests and off-site. These options will be updated if a change in learning model occurs.

Practice at School Facility:

Student-athletes must provide their own transportation to practice.

Home Contest:

Student-Athletes must provide their own transportation to all home contests.

Away Contest or Off-Site Team Practice:

Option 1: Independent Transportation

Students have the following options to get to their afterschool activity:

- If the student drives, they can transport themselves to practices that are off site.
- A parent/guardian can provide transportation.

Please Note:

- Carpooling is strongly discouraged
- If a positive case is part of a carpool, all passengers will be deemed a close contact per MDH guidelines. A close contact would then need to quarantine per MDH guidelines.

Option 2: School Provided Transportation

A bus to and from all contests will be offered to lower-level teams (9th, B-squad, and JV). Varsity players will drive to and from away games.

Please note:

- All School Transportation will follow the current guidelines set by MDH.
- If positive case rides a bus for a duration that exceeds more than 15 minutes, other passengers may be determined to be close contacts per MDH guidelines. A close contact would then need to quarantine per MDH guidelines.
