TSC schools and health services have been working to make necessary revisions to our school and health office practices to ensure that the school year can continue as safely as possible. All TSC practices and policies are based on current recommendations from the CDC, Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH), Indiana Department of Education (IDOE), and the Tippecanoe County Health Department (TCHD) and are subject to change as recommendations and guidelines from these sources are updated.

Please keep in mind that during the current remote session, it is very important that families continue to notify their school nurse of any COVID test results, pending COVID tests, and of any students who may be experiencing symptoms. If you are unsure of how to report this information to your child's school directly, please send an email to tscCOVID@tsc.k12.in.us.

Based on the recommendation of the Tippecanoe County Health Department, TSC schools will now utilize a 10 day quarantine for close contacts of individuals with COVID-19. Student athletes may return to school after a 10 day quarantine, but athletes will need to complete an additional four days of quarantine prior to returning to practices or games (i.e., a total of 14 days).
