

TRICT Free COVID-19 Testing for Symptomatic Center School District Students and Staff

Dear CSD Community,

Beginning January 11, 2021, Center School District will be offering free rapid COVID-19 testing for Center School District staff and students who are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms.

To obtain a test, participants must:

- 1) be symptomatic,
- 2) have an appointment, and
- 3) provide written consent.

Testing Availability

At this time, we plan to offer COVID testing for the remainder of Phase 1 of our Re-Entry Plan, pending the availability of nursing staff and testing supplies.

During Phase 2 of our re-entry plan, testing will continue to be offered, if possible, though availability will be limited.

Information About Abbotts's BinaxNOW Rapid Antigen Test Kits: The BinaxNOW rapid antigen test is a minimally invasive anterior nasal swab test. It is intended for qualitative detection of protein antigen from SARS CoV-2 in individuals suspected of COVID-19 within the first seven days of symptom onset. It must be administered by a trained health professional (e.g., nurse, doctor) and yields results in 15 minutes.

How to Request a COVID-19 Rapid Test Appointment: Call (816) 349-3309 for pre-authorization to schedule a testing appointment.

Consent: Written consent is required prior to obtaining a test. For students under age 18, a parent or guardian must be present and provide written consent.

Additional Information:

- The BinaxNow Rapid Test is only viable with individuals who are within day 1-7 of symptom onset.
- Tests are available **by appointment only** and require pre-authorization from a Center School District Nurse.
- There will be a limited number of testing appointments available on each scheduled testing day.
- The test is offered at **no cost** to CSD staff and students.
- The test is strictly voluntary/optional, and any student under the age of 18 must be accompanied by their parent or guardian, who will be required to provide consent for the test.
- Test results will be available approximately 15-20 minutes after being administered.
- The primary purpose of the test is to quickly identify COVID-19 positive individuals and isolate them at home so as not to spread the virus more widely.

- Any positive test result will require that individuals follow public health guidance.
- Any negative test result may necessitate further testing. Additionally, students/staff who test negative will not be permitted to return to school or work until further evaluation is completed and there is an improvement of symptoms.
