

Dear Fairfield Families,

We have a couple of Covid updates that we would like to share with you today.

You may have noticed that we are at 15 cases today. The superintendent's office and the DCHD have reviewed our case load and have determined that we can remain open due to case count data. We will drop 2 cases today, 2 tomorrow, 2 on Wednesday and 3 on Thursday. The number of new cases being added to our count have been small over the past week, either 0 or 1 each day. Thank you for all you are doing in your homes and in the community to keep our numbers low!

The DSD School Board and DCHD have adopted the new CDC guideline stating that quarantine will be 10 days instead of the previously required 14 days. This means that those asked to quarantine will be able to return either on day 11 if there have been no symptoms OR they may return sooner if they receive a negative test on day 7 or later and meet other requirements. If your child is required to quarantine you will receive an email with detailed information about these requirements and options.

We realize that information is constantly changing and being updated. Please don't hesitate to contact us with questions or concerns.
