COMMITTEE PROCESS


During meetings, committee members:



COMMITTEE DELIBERATIONS

Committee members were tasked with deliberating on which projects to include in a bond recommendation.



A 3-round process was put in place, with a goal of committee consensus on a proposed bond package by the end of deliberations. Depending on how tables voted, projects would be immediately accepted into the recommendation, marked for the next round of discussions, or eliminated from consideration.







COMMITTEE DELIBERATIONS

The committee only needed Round 1 to come to a consensus. All tables agreed on which projects to include to best meet the identified needs of the district.


















WESTWOOD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL CLASSROOM ADDITION

4-classroom addition to address anticipated growth within the district






CLINE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL REPLACEMENT

The committee unanimously voted that a new Cline Elementary would better serve the needs of the district as opposed to renovating the existing elementary school site.






BALES INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL CLASSROOM ADDITION

4-classroom addition to address anticipated growth within the district






WINDSONG INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL CLASSROOM ADDITION

6-classroom addition to address anticipated growth within the district




