

AT HOME...BEFORE SCHOOL

- Every morning, we need every student and staff to complete the daily health screener.
 - This google form will be emailed to you by 5:00 am.
 - It is checked each day by office staff.
 - If you do not complete this form, a staff member will be checking in with your child and contacting the family directly.
- Please make sure to bring your ipad (fully charged) and your backpack with your folders or binder from your teacher. This will be coming back and forth every day.
- We will offer breakfast or lunch, or your child can bring something to eat.

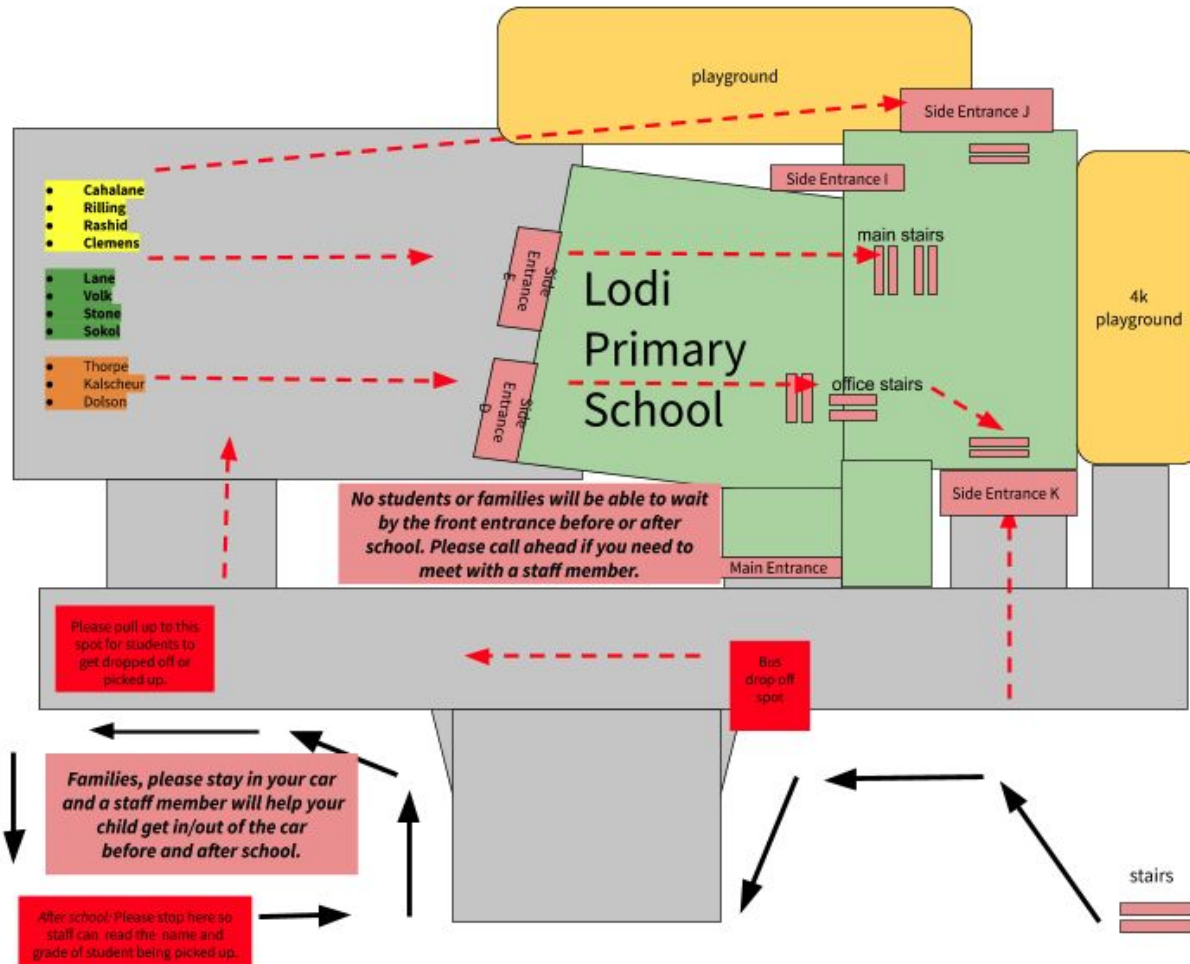

Students:

- **All students will have a tag with their name, teacher, and after school plans to ensure they get to the correct spot safely.**
- **Before school:** 4K students will go directly into the building through Entrance K.
- **After school:** 4k students will wait outside of the front of the school in a bus or pick up line.
- **Before school:** Grade K, 1 and 2 students will line up on spots in class lines on blacktop by the playground.
- **After school:** Grade K, 1 and 2 students will line up in a bus or pick up line where staff will help them get to their correct destinations.

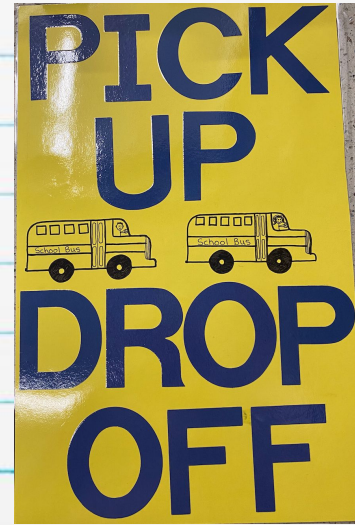
Drop off & Pick Up:

For everyone's safety we ask parents to stay in cars. We also ask that parents do not walk students into the building. If they need to talk to a staff member, they need to email or call the school.

If your child is getting picked up after school, please have a sign in the window with your child's name and grade. Staff will be looking at this to help get your child to your car.

STUDENTS RIDING THE BUS

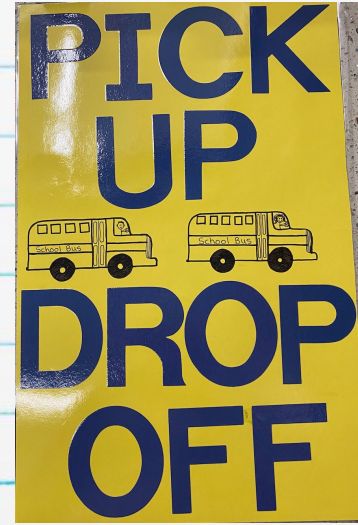
- Staff will start supervision at 7:45 am
- If your child is riding the bus, they will be dropped off in the bus loop by the yellow “Bus Drop Off/Pick Up” sign.
- Students will all be wearing a mask, stay as close to 6 feet away from each other as possible, and walk in a single file line to the playground blacktop if they are in grades K-2.

STUDENTS WALKING

- Staff will start supervision at 7:45 am.
- If your child is walking to school, they will walk on the sidewalk to the left of the parking lot and meet a staff member. Then they will walk to the playground blacktop.
- We will have a staff member helping students walking at the crosswalk at Ridgestone & Sauk as well as Sauk & Dale

STUDENTS DROPPED OFF

- If your child is getting dropped off, please use the parent loop and pull forward to the red “Car Drop Off/Pick Up” sign.
- PLEASE wait until an adult signals for your child to get out.
- All students will have a backpack tag that will help us identify your child’s name, teacher, grade, and after school plans. **Please have this on their backpack for the first day.** (THIS WILL BE IN YOUR SUPPLY PICK UP BAG ON JANUARY 13).

8:00 AM OR 12:30 PM- START OF SCHOOL

Staff will be waiting for students in grades K-2 on the playground blacktop.

- Signs will be in cones so that students know where to line up.
- Students will stand on a colored marking on the blacktop to ensure they are 6 feet away from other students.



8:00 AM OR 12:30 PM- START OF SCHOOL

- Classroom teachers will walk students into the building.
 - Students in grade K will enter the building through the side entrance **J** by the playground. **(VIDEO)**
 - Students in grade 1 (except Mrs. Volk's class) will enter through entrance **D** by the cafeteria. **(VIDEO)**
 - Students in grade 2 and Mrs. Volk's class will enter through entrance **E** and use the stairs to go up to their classroom. **(VIDEO)**

Classroom teachers will walk students out to the playground blacktop.

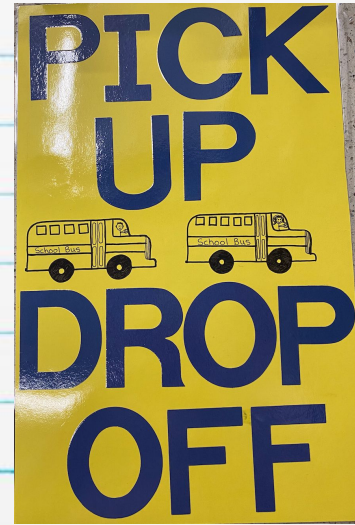
- 4k Students will be waiting outside the main doors.
- Signs will be in cones so that students know where to line up.
 - Students riding the bus will be in lines together.
 - Students getting pick up will be in lines together by alphabet and with siblings.
 - Students walking will be in a line together.
- Students will stand on a colored marking on the blacktop to ensure they are 6 feet away from other students.
- Safety is our #1 concern - we will try to get students dismissed as quickly as we can, but thank you for your patience.

STUDENTS RIDING THE BUS

- If your child is riding the bus, they will be walked by a staff member to the bus loop by the yellow “Bus Drop Off/Pick Up” sign.
- Students will all be wearing a mask, stay as close to 6 feet away from each other as possible, and walk in a single file line.

STUDENTS WALKING

- If your child is walking home, a staff member will lead them as they walk on the sidewalk to the left of the parking lot out of the school zone.
- If you walk your child, please make sure to be waiting by the “walker” area, wearing a mask, and keeping 6 feet distance from others.
- We will have a staff member helping students walking from the Primary to the High School and Middle School



STUDENTS PICKED UP

- If your child is picked up, please make sure you have a sign in your window with your child's name and grade. (THIS WILL BE IN YOUR SUPPLY PICK UP BAG ON JANUARY 13).
- Stop at the "red stop sign" so that a staff member can read the name(s). They will use a walkie to radio the staff on the playground of which students are ready to be picked up.
 - Another staff member will help your child get to your car.
- Pull forward to the yellow "Car Drop Off/Pick Up" sign.
- **Please** wait until an adult signals your child to get into the car.

- The preordered lunch meal or breakfast meal to take home must be preordered weekly for the following week. Orders are due no later than Wednesday at 2:00 pm.
