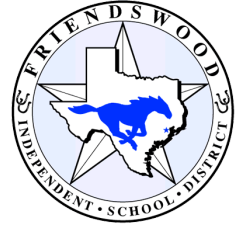


FISD School Safety Advisory Committee

1. School Safety Audits

Mr. Kreiter went over the safety audits and a few improvements that need to be made to make our campuses safer and more compliant. Mr. Kreiter also reviewed information about security officers and visitors on campuses. Mr. Kreiter then went over observations made at various campuses including fencing, portable classrooms, landscapes, signage, etc.. These audits need to be reviewed by this committee prior to being submitted to the Texas School Safety Center.

2. COVID

Mr. Kreiter discussed the recent numbers for COVID. He reported that we currently have 10 cases in the District. Mr. Kreiter also reported that the physician, Dr. Keiser, with the Galveston County Health District told them in a meeting that although there is an uptick in COVID cases, there has not been an increase to hospitalizations or deaths. Mr. Kreiter also reported on the possibility of vaccines being distributed soon. There were several comments regarding close contact and the definition of close contacts. He commended the District staff and parents on adhering to District mandates and helping to keep the COVID numbers down. Administrators on the committee also expressed
