- **Must** be 21 prior to first day of class
- **Must have** HS Diploma or GED
- **Must** provide proof of United States citizenship or resident alien status
- **Must pass** the Physical Assessment prior to acceptance. Will be administered by MNTC prior to class start date
- **Must pass** the reading, writing, and comprehension examination (POSSE exam – 70%)
Information about testing provided during orientation
- **Must complete** and return 15-page application no later than 12:00 pm May 24th, 2021.
Application must be returned to MNTC Franklin Road Campus, Attention: Jerry McConnell.
- **Must have** a fingerprint search submitted to The Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation and the Federal Bureau of Investigation with the return report supplied to the academy director in an unopened envelope. (we will provide them with the forms at the orientation meeting)
- **No** Felony Convictions
- **No** Protective Orders
- **Cannot** have a deferred sentence agreement for a felony, a crime involving moral turpitude or a crime of domestic violence.
- **Cannot** have any criminal charges pending in any court in this state, another state, in tribal court or pursuant to the United States Code.
- **Cannot be currently undergoing treatment for a mental illness, condition or disorder**
