General Description

The Library Media Specialist (LMS) leads the library services on Zug Campus. They will have an opportunity to develop a vision for both the physical space and the future of library services for the Primary and Middle School. In addition, the position provides an opportunity to lead a collaborative process to articulate and implement a plan that will result in innovative learning spaces, support for our holistic educational programme, and encouragement of the professional learning of all staff. Successful candidates will understand that professionally managed and resourced school libraries are crucial to the achievements of the school community. They will have the skill set to manage the day to day operation of all library functions and will understand curriculum needs to work directly with learners (students and faculty alike). The LMS is a full-time position that will commence in August of 2021.

Working with ISZL Students

- Foster a welcoming physical environment and culture that encourages access to, and use of, library and library services, in line with our wellbeing and learning principles.
- Plan, design and deliver instructional services and programmes to foster students' research information skills and digital literacy.
- Measure library resources, facilities, programs and services against current policies and curriculum documents and identify how to enhance services
- Plan for and initiate events, author visits, workshops, book clubs, displays (in liaison with Faculty leaders)
- Lead the communication and promotion of primarily electronic resources/ collections and services
- Provide reference services and assistance in identifying and locating materials
- Understand, model and teach about copyright, open domain, fair use, transformative use and creative commons in conjunction with the school academic honesty policy
- Stay current with library trends to be able to promote literature and resources to all patrons

Working with ISZL Colleagues

- Mentor, coach and support teachers, other staff and students on the use of resources, strategies of inquiry and resource based learning to help them research and teach more effectively.
- Attend planning meetings and collaborate with classroom teachers and specialists to design and implement effective units of inquiry to support interdisciplinary and transdisciplinary learning.
- Work collaboratively to organise library activities, displays, special events and activities to support student learning within the PYP and MYP programmes.
- Plan for and provide library orientation programmes for staff and students
- Collaborate with Director of Operations and a facilities committee to develop the physical spaces into contemporary, attractive and efficient learning spaces
- Work with other ISZL librarians in an on-going manner to review and create library policies, procedures and programmes.

Working with ISZL Parents and External Community

- Ensure Circulation Desk support for all community members
 - Initiate and support Book Clubs for all members of the community
 - Plan for learning events (book events, speakers, displays)
